Ask the HOA...

Q: Who is responsible for the berm?

A: It is the responsibility of the property owner to mow the berm outside of their property as part of the general land maintenance. Ignoring this area will lead to violations and fines.



Q: How do I keep neighbors off my property?

A: South Carolina has several laws regarding trespassing on private property. Trespassing is considered a misdemeanor and can result in fines of up to \$200 and/or up to 30 days in jail for a first offense.
