Statewide Lacrosse Officials' Game Fee Schedule

Boys and Girls

Game fees throughout the state are close, but not exactly the same and that can cause issues when officials travel outside their home district. Further, market conditions have created a shortage of skilled professionals, including officials, across the state. To address the shortage, and incent Wisconsin's best and brightest to become lacrosse officials, the below fee rotation schedule is proposed - to be effective beginning January 1, 2023.

2022 game rates will not change with this schedule. For 2023 and beyond, there will be a 3-year fee increase rotation to help teams with budgeting purposes. All rate schedules will be published each Summer/Fall to ensure it is properly communicated.

- Year 1, varsity game fees increase by \$5.00
- Year 2, JV game fees increase by \$5.00
- Year 3, Youth game fees increase by \$5.00
 - o After 8 years the 1-man youth game will increase \$10 to maintain 1 ½ game fee
- Year 4, this rotation then starts again with an increase to the varsity game fees.
