NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SMITH TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF MAHONING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Board of Trustees of the GRANTEE (the "Board") finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the GRANTEE to enter into the Grant Agreement to accept the NEC Grant(s) for Grant(s) funds.
