

Health and Safety Policy Statement

In line with 'Our Purpose', we will meet our primary purpose legally and safely. This is not negotiable. The following statement lays out the framework through which we will achieve this.

Our Culture

As a business we are committed to maintaining a strong and positive culture that supports the Company Purpose and Vision, both of which are clear that we will operate legally and safely.

Our culture will be such that all employees within the Company care about each other's health, safety and wellbeing, and are committed to delivering the five Ps.

Compliance with our Health and Safety Policy will ensure that the Company provides a safe workplace by managing issues proactively, and with due consideration to industry "best practice" appropriate to the purpose, size and context of the organisation, and to the specific nature of its risks and opportunities.

Our Commitments

UKPSS Itd is committed to eliminating hazards and reducing risks together with ensuring – and continually improving – the health, safety and welfare of all its employees as far as is reasonably practicable.

UKPSS Itd outsources H&S to a qualified Health and Safety Manager to meet its health and safety obligations and responsibilities. The Health and Safety company oversees the Health & Safety policy through communication, education and training, regular health and safety audits, and ongoing support to the operations.

The successful implementation of this policy requires the total commitment of employees at all levels to embrace and adhere to the Company's health and safety processes.

Legal Requirements

UKPSS Itd fully accepts responsibility for other persons who may be affected by its activities, including visitors, contractors and the general public.

Each individual has a legal obligation to take reasonable care of his or her own health and safety, and the safety of other people who may be affected by his or her acts or omissions.
