Under President Biden

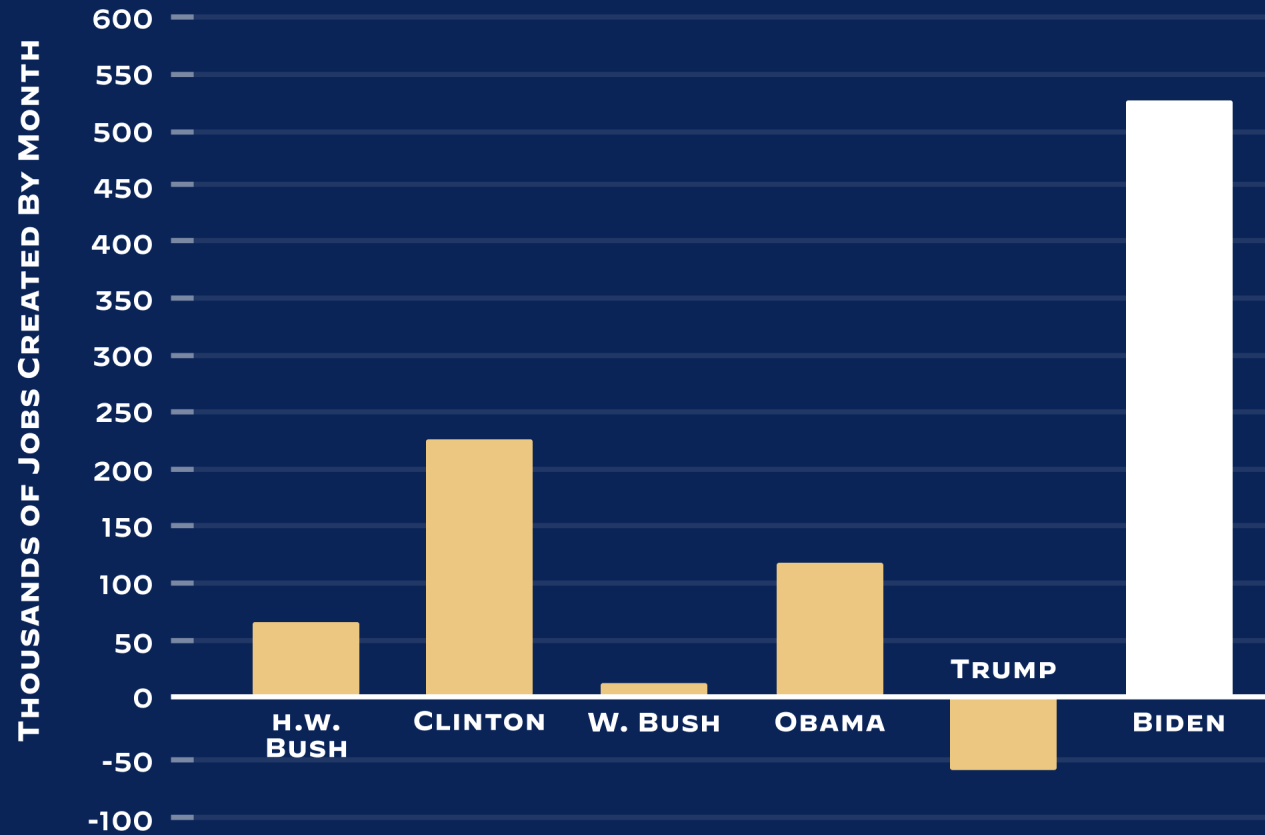
- ✔ Senate passed the Inflation Reduction Act
- ✔ Congress passed the CHIPS and Science Act
- ✔ The U.S. carried out a successful counterterrorism mission against the leader of al Qaeda
- ✔ Congress passed the PACT Act, a historic bill to address veteran burn pit exposure
- ✔ Gas is below \$4 in over half of all gas stations
- ✔ Senate ratifies NATO accession protocols for Sweden and Finland
- ✔ Executive Order protecting reproductive rights is signed

What President Biden's climate proposal that just passed the Senate means...

FOR THE COUNTRY

- ✔ 950 million solar panels operating by 2030
- ✔ 120,000 wind turbines operating by 2030
- ✔ 2,300 grid-scale battery plants to store clean energy by 2030

By manufacturing more of these technologies in the United States we will create more good-paying, union jobs

FOR YOU

- ✔ Up to \$14,000 in rebates for efficient appliances and home upgrades
 - Saving families **\$350** per year on energy bills
- ✔ 30% tax credit to install solar panels
 - Saving families **\$300** per year on electricity
- ✔ A tax credit for electric vehicles
 - Saving families **\$950** per year when they make the switch

Lowering Health Care Costs

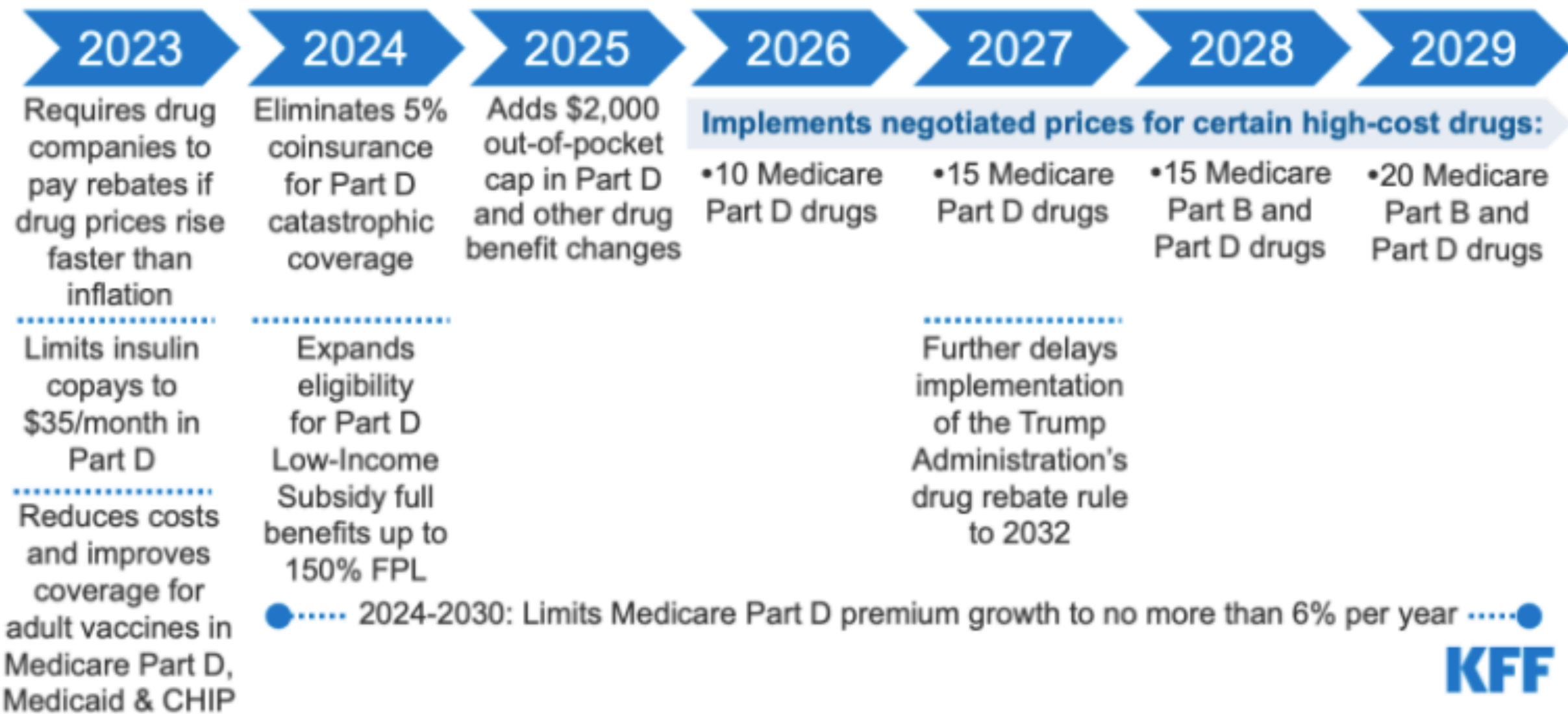
- The uninsured rate is at an all-time low of 8%, which the historic law will build on
- 13 million Americans will continue to save an average of \$800 per year on health insurance premiums
- 3 million more Americans will have health insurance than without the law.



Cutting Prescription Drug Cost

- Americans pay 2-3X what citizens of other countries pay for prescription drugs
- Negotiate prescription drug costs for Medicare
 - 5-7 million Medicare beneficiaries could see their prescription drug costs go down.
- Medicare \$2000 out of pocket cap for prescription drugs -
 - 50 million Americans with Medicare Part D will have the peace of mind knowing their costs at the pharmacy are capped at \$2,000 per year, directly benefiting about 1.4 million beneficiaries each year.
- Insulin capped at \$35/month -
 - 3.3 million Medicare beneficiaries with diabetes will benefit from a guarantee that their insulin costs are capped at \$35 for a month's supply.

Defeating Special Interests

- \$187 million:
 - The amount the Pharmaceutical industry has spent on lobbying in 2022.
- 1,600:
 - number of lobbyists the pharmaceutical companies had in 2021 – three times the number of Members of Congress
- 33 years:
 - the amount of time Congressional Democrats have been trying to lower prescription drug costs by allowing Medicare to negotiate drug prices.
- 19 years:
 - number of years Medicare has been blocked from negotiating prescription drug costs



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
