

Support Matt Kilboy for Congress on Nov. 8

Ohio Nurses for America urges a vote for Matt Kilboy, a nurse and Navy veteran, in the 14th Congressional District race in November. This sprawling district includes the counties of Ashtabula, Lake, Geauga, Trumbull, and most of Portage County.

Kilboy demonstrates the integrity and decision-making skills needed to serve in Congress. Meanwhile, Republican U.S. Rep. David Joyce has a voting record out of sync with Ohioans. While we pay outrageous prices at the pump, Joyce voted "no" on the Consumer Fuel Price Gouging Prevention Act.
