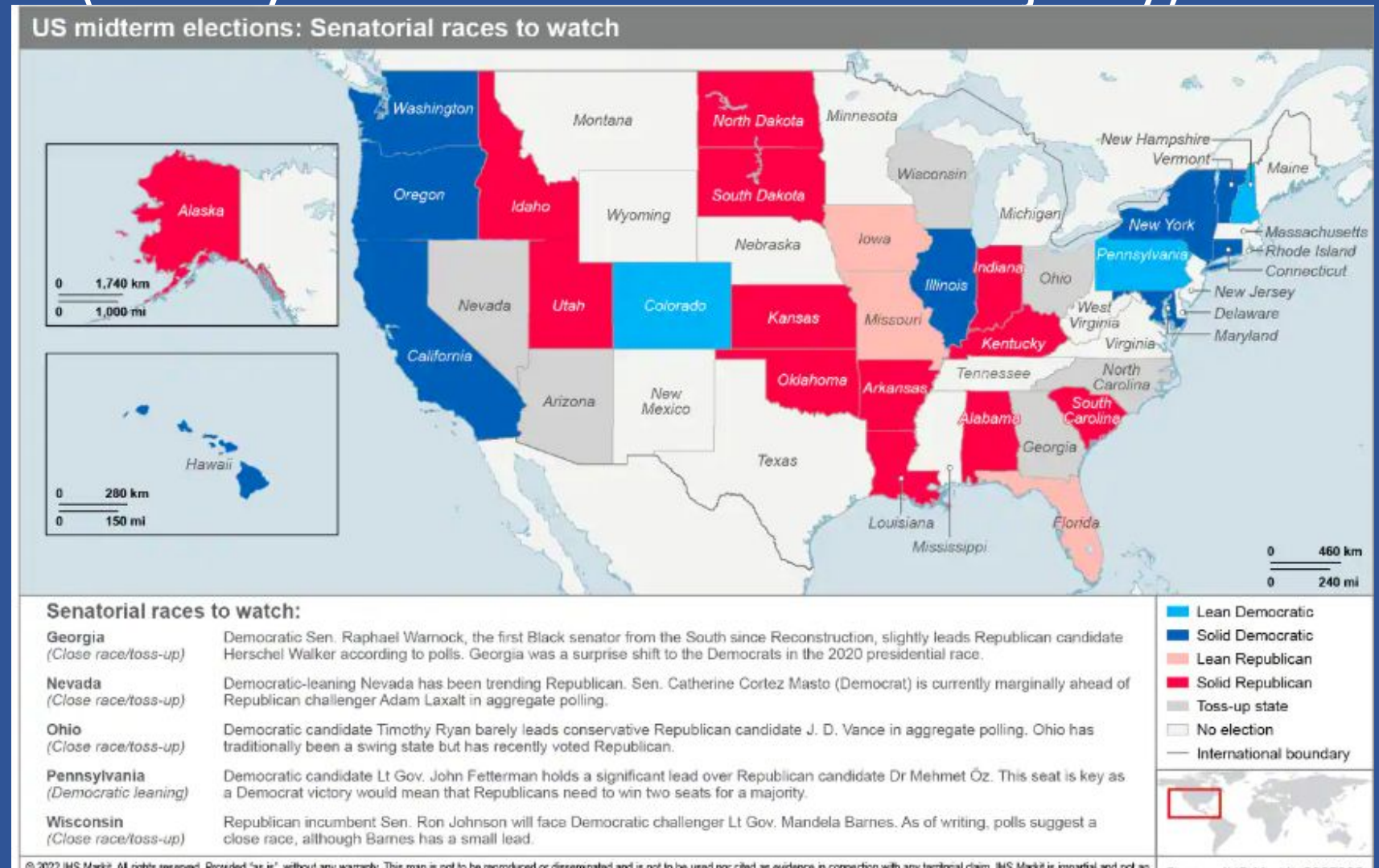
State Races that might influence the election outcomes:

- Governors Races - can take Emergency Executive Action (after census, many state Governors appoint the committees that draw new House district lines.
- Secretary of State Races - Registration, Voting, Counting the votes and certifying the election
- Attorney General Races - responsible for halting illegal practices, investigating accusations of violating voting laws. State's chief law enforcement officer
