

The 100% Biodegradable FFC series, the Fluoro-Free Competition waxes from DOMINATOR

DOMINATOR's effective, economical and 100% biodegradable FFC series uses nanotechnology instead of fluoro to increase the water repellency of the wax. FFC waxes are ideal for junior competitors and performance seekers and as training waxes for top competitors. As with the other DOMINATOR series, there are three steps with FFC waxing: Base prep, glide wax, and rub-on.

Base Prep

FFC 1



Base conditioning wax with an advanced technology antistatic additive. For hot scrape cleaning: iron in, scrape while warm, and brush well. For base conditioning: iron in, wait at least 15 minutes, scrape and brush well. For travel waxing: after hot scraping, iron in a layer and scrape and brush after traveling.

Glide waxes

FFC 2 / FFC 2C




For snow temperatures of -7°C / 19°F and warmer with a complex antistatic package; iron in, for best results wait one to two hours, scrape and brush



For snow temperatures of -7°C / 19°F and colder with an antistatic package suitable for aggressive snow. Ideal for fresh manmade snow or hard frozen snow at any temperature.

Can be mixed with FFC 2 to harden

Can be mixed with FFC 2 to harden it at the colder part of its range; iron in, wait for 5-10 minutes, scrape and brush



Rub-on

Gray bar: A fluoro-free version of our very successful BUTTER, it works best on soft, wet snow. If you can make a snowball that sticks together, this is the time for the wet snow FFC bar. Rub lightly on the base, cork in, brush out, do not polish.

Black bar: For most snow conditions, and as a refresher wax between runs. Always use on new man-made snow at any temperature. Rub lightly on the base, cork in to a shine, do not brush.
