Our spa cover inspection checklist was created to help you quickly determine if your spa cover needs to be replaced. If any of the following apply to your cover, we highly recommend a genuine Caldera® Spas replacement cover.

VINYL	FOAM CORES	HINGE
These symptoms will affect the safety, heat retention and beauty of your cover. Dry Brittle	Foam cores are critical to heat retention and safety. Cores can be replaced, but for covers over two years old, core replacement is not recommended.	Precious heat can escape if a hinge tear goes beyond the Heat Seal Shoe (approx. 2" from the outside edge).
