making them less vulnerable to a Wildfire. Presently, due to Budget Restraints, CSRD is only able to fund 1 bin for us to use. The 2<sup>nd</sup> bin's cost is being covered by a federal government grant of \$750 plus funds from our St. Ives Rate Payers Association.

The cost of providing the 11 bins we used last year were covered by a Post Fire one time grant from the government. This grant isn't available to CSRD this year. The number of communities now wanting to participate in a FireSmart program has greatly increased. However, the funding has remained the same.

The reality is in the future we have to do more with less.

Pricing for the bins are as follows:

- > \$435 for delivery to St Ives
- \$500 pick up and delivery to dump
- \$15/day for as long as the bin is in St Ives

We wish to Thank CSRD for the **11 bins** we filled last year!

These are very large sums for our community to absorb yearly. For the future we'll have to possibly look into fundraising to have them available for us to use.

The prediction is we are in a drought period estimated as year 7 of a 36 year cycle. Wildfires are becoming our new reality apparently. Helping FireSmart our community does help.

Everyone's actions count but we are not done. Making your home FireSmart is a **YEARLY** task. We cannot be less vigilant in our clean ups, especially after witnessing the results from the Bush Creek East Wildfire of 2023.

This could be the last year that \$500 grants are available to help you FireSmart your home & property. There is a dollar value assigned to every job needed to be done. It's up to you how much or little you want.
