### **Preface**

This document is designed as a guide to provide information on services addressing substance use in Saskatchewan. It contains information about drug and alcohol withdrawal management, treatment centers, recovery services, mental health and addictions support, harm reduction programs and services, opioid assisted therapies, peer programs and support groups, and additionally provides contact information for the federally administered National Native Alcohol and Drug Abuse programs. The purpose of this document is to provide a comprehensive resource listing substance use services in Saskatchewan and to facilitate access to the services described within.

This document is structured by geographical region and primary service type. The province of Saskatchewan is separate into three broad geographic service regions: Northern, Central and Southern and Saskatchewan. Beyond this, services and supports are further distinguished to note larger cities and rural and remote communities within each geographic region. Each regional section notes the primary services for each organization listed along with contact information, and a link to their website. However, additional services and referrals may be available. We encourage readers to contact the organization directly for a full description of their current services and to connect with a care provider. Further, if services or supports are available but not listed in this document or our listing is inaccurate, we encourage readers to visit <a href="https://www.p5projectyxe.ca">www.p5projectyxe.ca</a> and use the Contact Us feature so we can update as necessary.

Individuals seeking services should explore their closest available services according to geographic region. Beyond the geographic structure, the document is broken down into two categories for each region. Each region has a table combined with withdrawal management, treatment and opioid agonist therapy services and a table containing mental health and addictions supports. Furthermore, the listings provide details about the organization including contact information, substance use-related services offered, provision of take-home naloxone kits (THN), membership in the National Native Alcohol and Drug Abuse Program (NNADAP) to serve First Nations and Inuit populations, or availability of youth-specific services. For direct information on what services your location offers, see Appendix A, a full list of services offered in Saskatchewan categorized by region. For direct information on where to access opioid agonist therapies in Saskatchewan, see Appendix B. For direct information on where to access take home naloxone kits in Saskatchewan, see Appendix C.



### Stigma & Language

Stigma is a negative attitude or belief associated with a particular circumstance, quality, or person. People who use drugs/substances (PWUD) are often stigmatized and this can have significant impacts their health wellbeing, treatment and recovery journeys, and their family and friends. Stigma is a barrier that PWUD may face in many aspects of their lives including when accessing health care and social/human services, seeking housing and other basic needs, connecting with social supports such as family, friends and the broader community, and creating and perpetuating shame and negative self-image among PWUD.

One common way stigma of PWUD persists is through use of stigmatizing language. Some commonly used words and phrases can perpetuate negative attitudes and beliefs by reinforcing ideas of individual and moral failure of those who use substances. In the remainder of this section, we provide person-first and less stigmatizing language suggestions for commonly used terms and phrases pertaining to PWUD and some definitions of terms found frequently throughout this document.


### **Terminology:**

There are many complementary approaches to addressing substance use and substance use disorders, and our classification of services is based on the following definitions. Services listed in this document may have a different understanding of the terms used and we suggest following up with service providers directly if clarification on what they provide is needed. Each term is followed by an additional resource for further information. If you are not sure of the best resource for your situation, we suggest contacting the Saskatchewan Mental Health and Addictions referral line at 306-655-7777.

Terminology	Definition	Additional Resource
Harm Reduction (HR)	Any service that aims to reduce the harms of substance use such as safe consumption, overdose prevention or needle exchange; distribution of safer drug use supplies including safer inhalation/smoking or injection kits; or provision of naloxone kits. NOTE: not all harm reduction agencies offer all services listed above. If unsure about what harm reduction programming is offered at an agency, please follow-up with that agency directly.	https://www.hri.global /what-is-harm-reduction
Withdrawal Management (WM)	Any service that aims to assist an individual with reducing the physical and psychological impacts of reducing or stopping the habitual use of a substance. When a person is physically dependent on a substance, stopping abruptly can cause harmful impacts on the body. Treatment and Recovery	These terms are often used interchangeably but are distinguished in this document.  Treatment means engaging a process that is guided by a trained professional to address substance use, often in a clinical or residential setting. There are numerous approaches to treatment. The best approach depends on each individual situation and available evidence and resources. A treatment professional can provide the best assessment and guidance for accessing local treatment options.	https://www.ccsa.ca/r esearch-treatment- support-and-recovery
	Recovery means different things to different people. For some it is abstinence from substance use and for other it means experiencing a better quality of life. Recovery can encompass any service or support that assists a person with achieving or maintaining their goals.  *For this document: Treatment means any program or service offered by a trained professional to assist an individual with addressing their substance use. Recovery services means any program or service that is used to maintain the outcomes of a treatment program, or that broadly encourage a more conscientious relationship with the substance of use and promote wellbeing in daily life.	
Opioid Assisted/Agonist Therapies (OAT)	An effective treatment that involves taking the opioid agonists methadone or buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone). Outpatient or Day Program	A patient who is not hospitalized overnight but who does treatment and/or recovery in mental health clinics, counsellors' offices, or hospital.	
Inpatient or Residential Program	Inpatient treatment may be part of a hospital program or treatment center, where you will sleep at the facility and get therapy.






