Seabrooks. Old Mrs Flenner was a Zimmerman, the last to be buried at Carrollsburg cemetery. Family connections to Flenners in Section A3 14-17;E 108-111. Zimmerman's English spelling is Carpenter ordered by Wm Penn to anglesize the spelling. Hans Zimmerman (1673-1749)was ancestor of Seabrooks and Jacob Ferree II (C2 231;D30).
