Agnew Family

Mary Irwin(4/2/1772-1824), daughter of John Irwin and Mary(Hoag), from Franklin Co, PA Antrim Twp. Was 17 yrs old when she married David Agnew who was 29 yrs old.. He was son of James Agnew(1711-1770) who was born in Ireland-Clan Colla. James was a Capt of Associated Company, York Co. PA in defense of frontier in the French and Indian War. James was married twice. First wife unknown except that they had 2

children. Second wife was Rebecca (Scott). They had 9 children. David was an Ensign in the Rev War, 2nd Battalion, York Co. militia under the command of Col Robert McPherson. David's brothers also served: Capt John, Ensign Samuel, Col James II who married Mary Ramsay. Ensign David and Mary (Irwin)had 12 children: Anne, James (died young), John, David, Jr., Rebecca Hays, Mary M. (Married Samuel M. Reed), Robert, Samuel (Died 1812 from war wounds), Martha Lashells, Smith, James (named after brother that died young), Gibson (born 5 months before father died).

Four years after David died his widow married in 1801 the Rev Alexander Dobbin who performed 216 marriages in his career.
