WOODVILLE WARRIORS

Woodville District Basketball Club competes in South Australia's junior and senior basketball competitions. We are one of just 10 member clubs in Basketball SA's elite competitions and have pathways to state and national representation. We provide complete pathways from 6-year-olds to seniors. The Warriors are the elite basketball offering of the Westside Basketball Association.



NBL 1 CENTRAL

The NBL1 Central league is the 2nd highest basketball league in Australia. NBL1 Central, formerly the Premier League, is a semi-professional basketball league in South Australia, comprising both a men's and women's competition.

The NBL1 is a nationally run league with an international flavour. With players from all over the world participating and games streamed internationally the NBL1 is a respected and revered basketball pathway to the WNBL and the WNBA.



WESTSIDE BASKETBALL

Our Association pathway is through the Westside Basketball Association this is aimed at children who are just starting basketball. Association is all played at St Clair on a Saturday afternoon with 1 training on a Sunday afternoon. Each seasons run for the school term.

Westside Basketball is a coordinated introductory program covering children from schools across the whole region and supported by volunteer coaches some of whom are NBL1 Players.



WESTSIDE CHURCH BASKETBALL

In 1968, the Salvation Army Basketball Association (SA) was born on the Coca-Cola Courts at Thebarton, continuing for 50 years until The Salvation Army ceased their involvement in June 2018. The competition continued last year at the Titanium Security Arena under the name 'Monday Night Church Basketball' with guidance and support from Basketball SA.

In 2019, the competition moved to the St Clair Recreation Centre and changed our name to 'Westside Church Basketball'. The opportunity to play basketball on Monday nights at a new six-court venue and to partner with the newly formed Westside Basketball Association (in developing basketball in Adelaide's western suburbs) and YMCA South Australia (as centre managers) was too good an opportunity to pass up and we are truly excited about what the future might bring.

NBL1

The leading semi-professional basketball league in Australia

NBL1 comprises of both Men and Women's competitions from South, North, Central, West Conferences and East Conferences.

State governing bodies govern their respective conference with the league including 72 clubs from across every state and territory in Australia.

In 2019, the league proceeded the SEABL (South East Australian Basketball League), which at the time was Australia's pre-eminent semi-professional basketball league, and had been since 1981.

The NBL1 Central league is the 2nd highest basketball league in Australia.

NBL1 Central, formerly the Premier League, is a semi-professional basketball league in South Australia, comprising both a men's and women's competition.

In 2020, Basketball South Australia partnered with the National Basketball League (NBL) to bring NBL1 to South Australia. NBL1 replaced the former Premier League to create more professional pathways and opportunities for males and females playing basketball in South Australia. As a result, the Premier League became the central conference of NBL1. Many of the players in our league are current and former NBL and WNBL athletes, compete in professional leagues all over the world and at US universities. It takes funding to run a national level program and we cannot do it without sponsorships.

Organised sports positive effect

AUSPLAY™ National Sport and Physical Activity Participation Report November 2022

AusPlay commenced in October 2015 and is the largest and most comprehensive survey of its kind ever conducted in Australia. Each year, 20,000 Australian residents aged 15 or over complete the survey.

Apart from providing information about their own participation, parents/guardians of children under the age of 15 are asked about the organised physical activities undertaken by one of their children aged 0–14 outside of school hours.

It's recent National Sport and Physical Activity Participation Report identified Basketball as 4th most participated sport for boys and 6th for girls aged 0-14yrs.

The study also outlined findings regarding COVID-19 affects on organised sport and participation, identifying the sport participations positive association with mental health.
