After the year 1453 the Oyinbo started to come to Africa. They came from across the desert and the ocean.

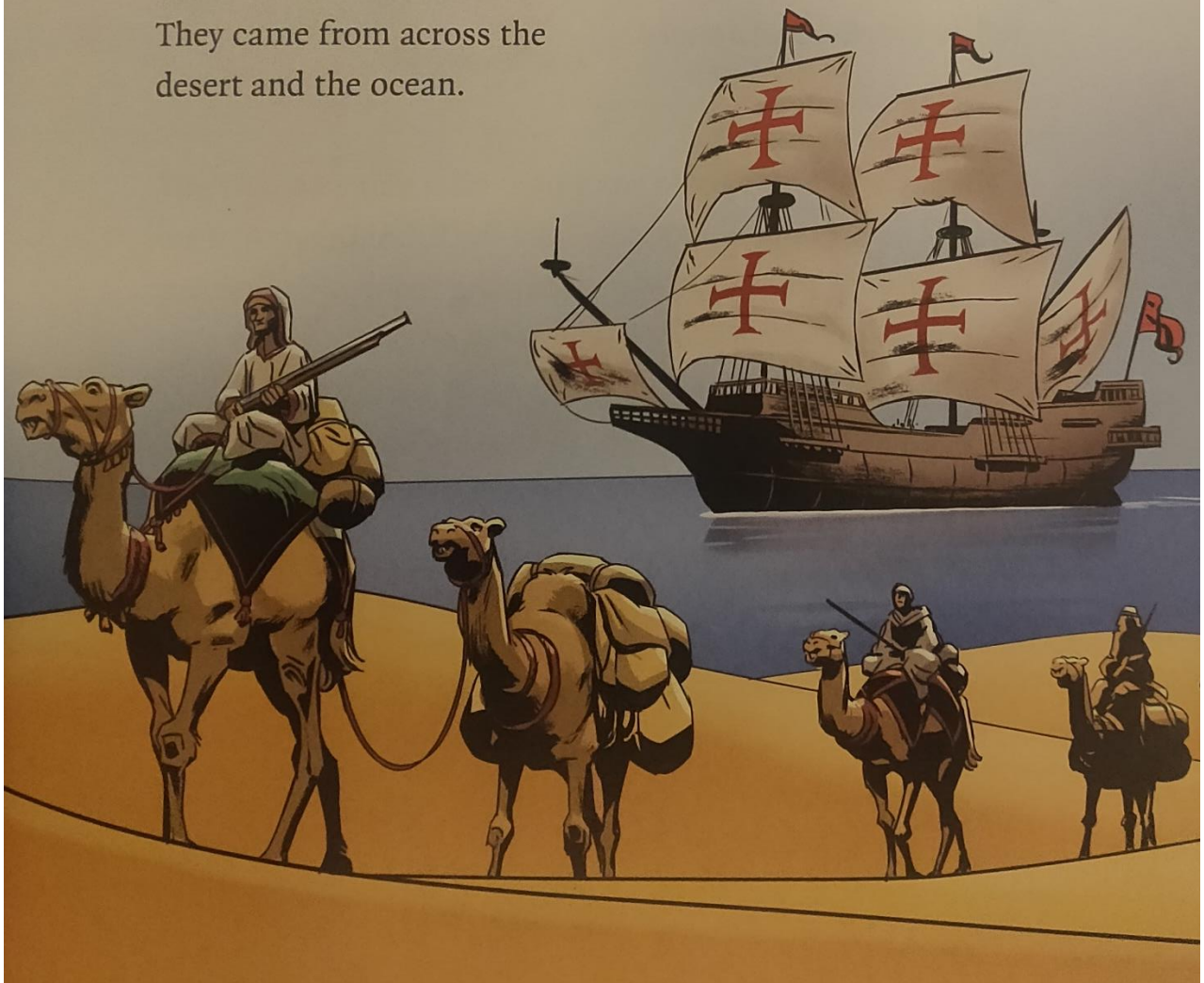


Figure 5 - A Beginning of the current Sorrows

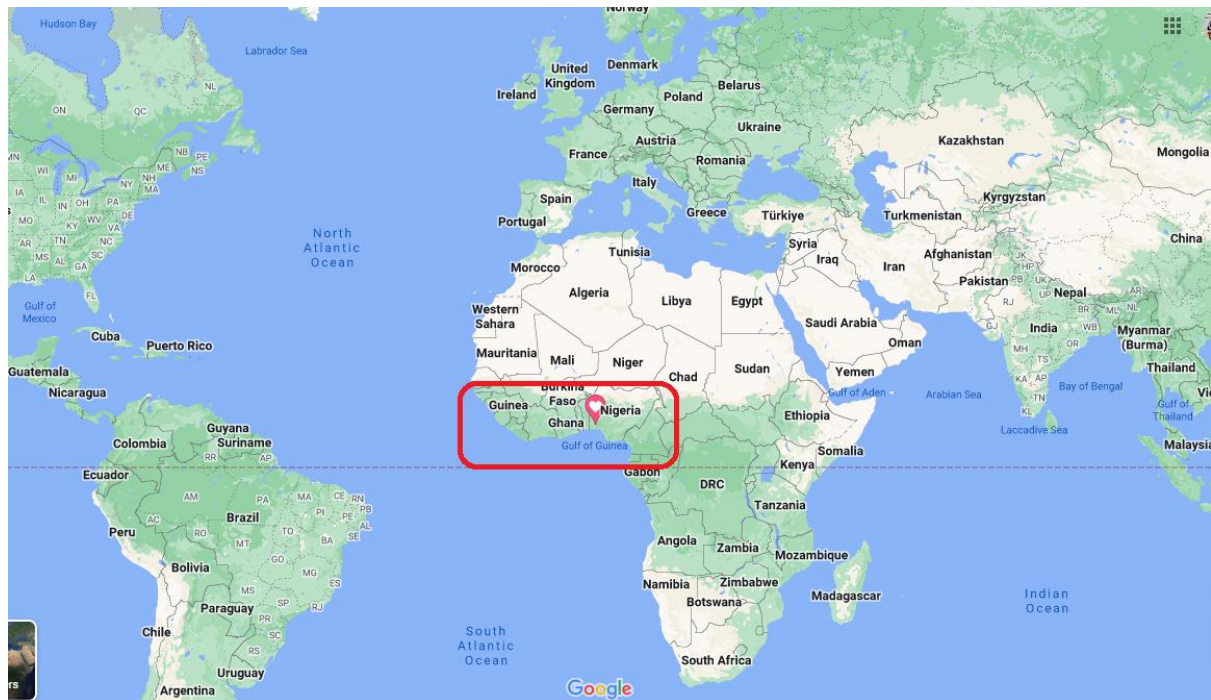


Figure 7 - West Africa – “The high level Picture”

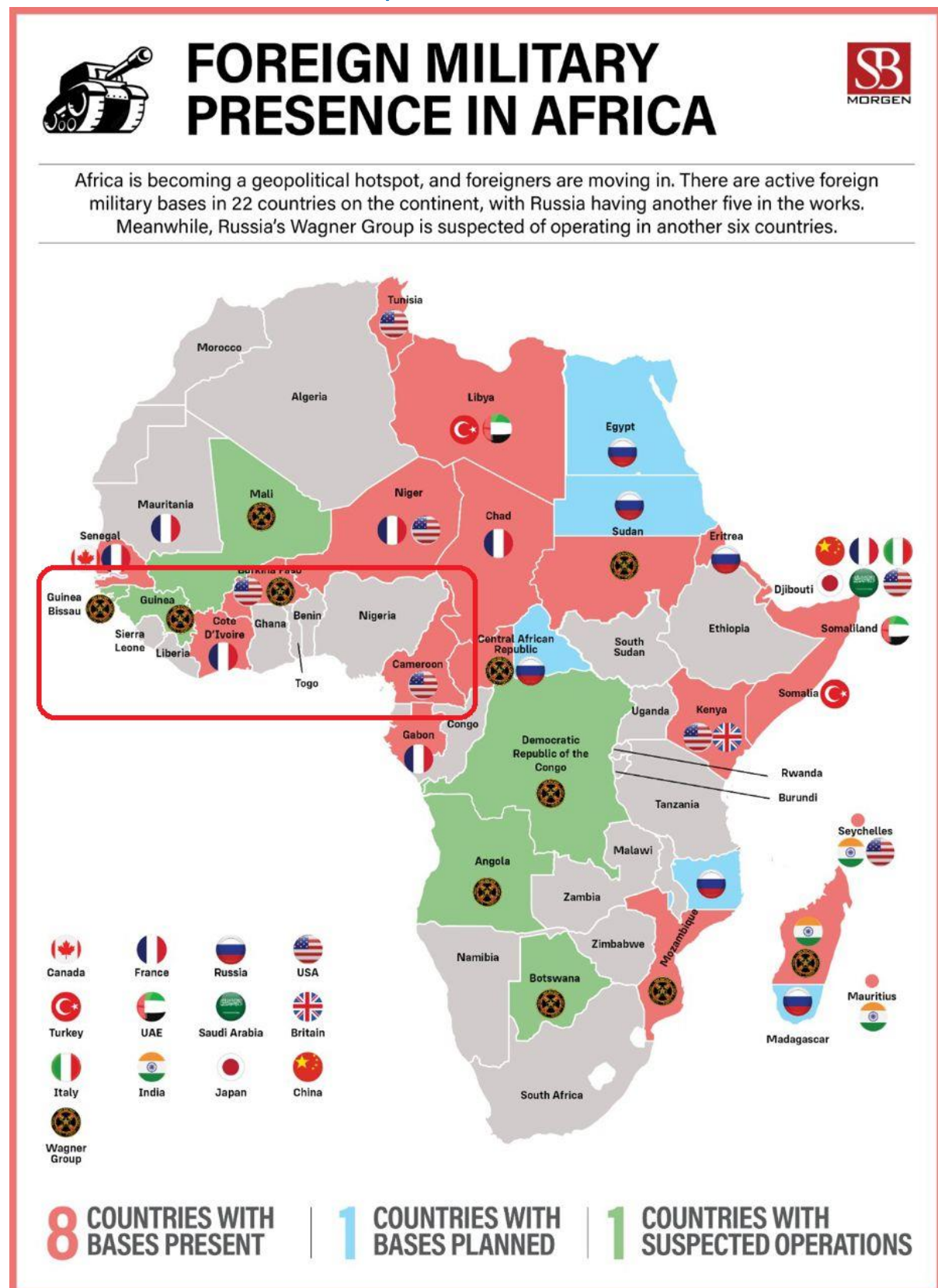


Figure 8 - Foreign Military Presence in Africa

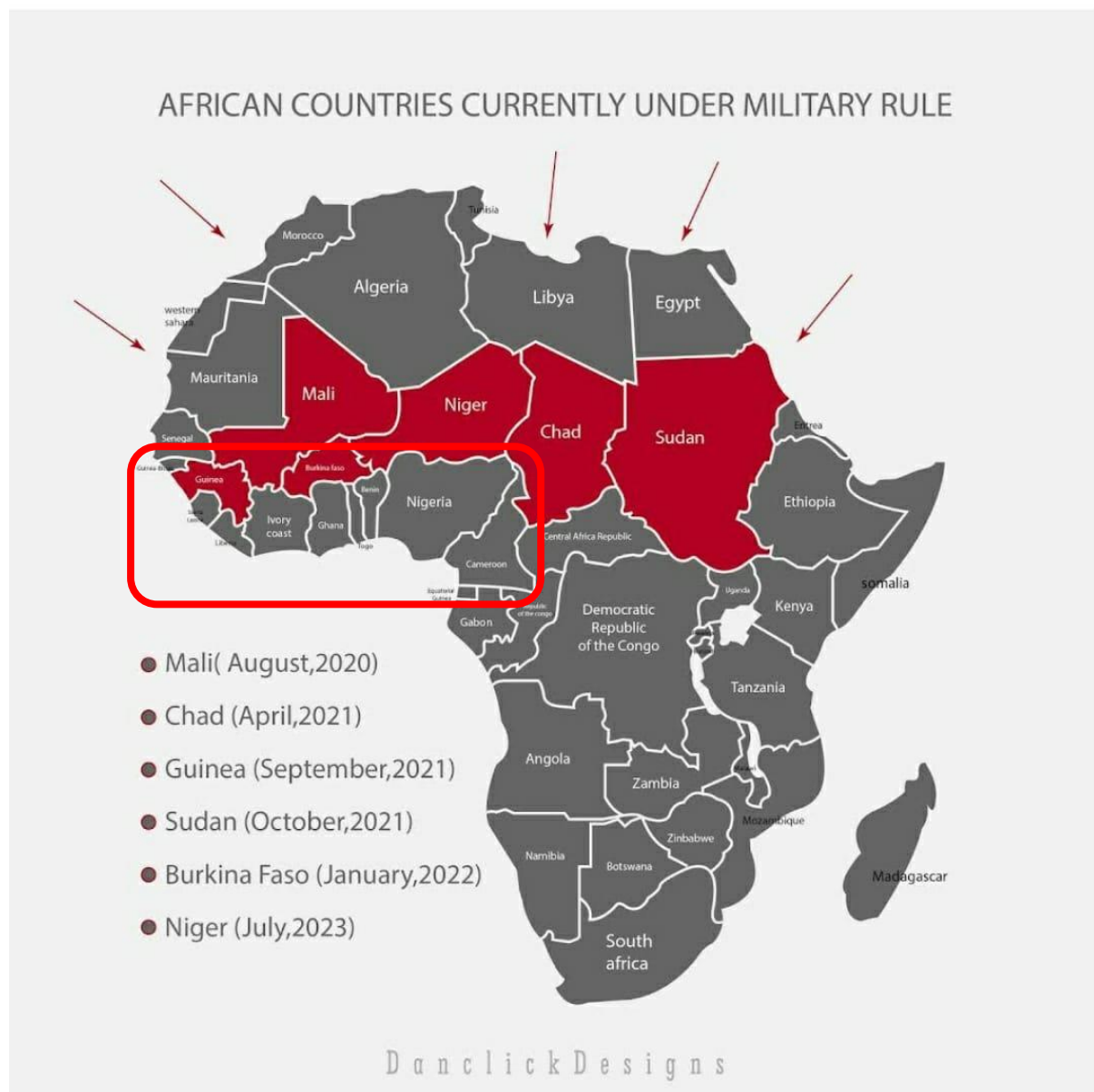


Figure 9 - Military Rule in Africa

It is no exaggeration to say that the tactics to which the combination of Robertson and McPherson resorted in the implementation of the Colonial Office's plan were responsible for the failure of democracy in Nigeria. The British authorities played a decisive part in the selection of politicians for ministerial posts. Once the politician became a Minister he was made, and he became a much more powerful politician. The essence of colonial rule is that politics is banned for the people of the country while the colonial regime engages in full time politics. The notion that colonial administration functions without politics would be laughable to those administrators or political officers engaged in the trade.

The politics of the colonial regime are employed in the selection, destruction and manipulation of the leaders of the native people....The major aim of all this is to encourage friends of the colonial regime, people who are 'sound,' that is prepared to betray their own people's interests for personal advancement, and to put down irresponsible elements, that is to say nationalist politicians who act in their people's interests and cannot be bribed.

A major proportion of the politicians who made Nigeria notorious for corruption after Independence were selected by the British before Independence. The politicians and leaders and men of eminence not chosen were often honest, trustworthy and responsible people. Why were these people not brought in by the British? The answer is that the British needed people they could control. They sometimes selected crooks whom they knew they could control after Independence. Balewa, the leader from the North, was of course the exception, as was Awolowo. Balewa was so pro-British that he hardly needed manipulating. He was sound because he took advice from his band of British advisors⁵⁴

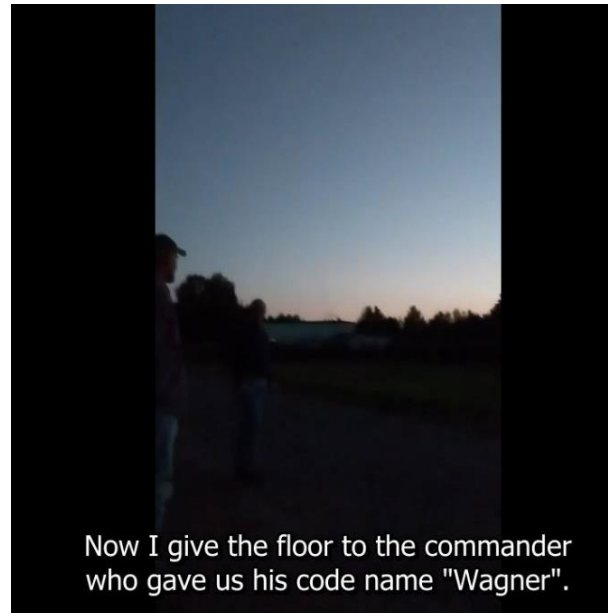
Figure 12 - Helping to democratise Military might

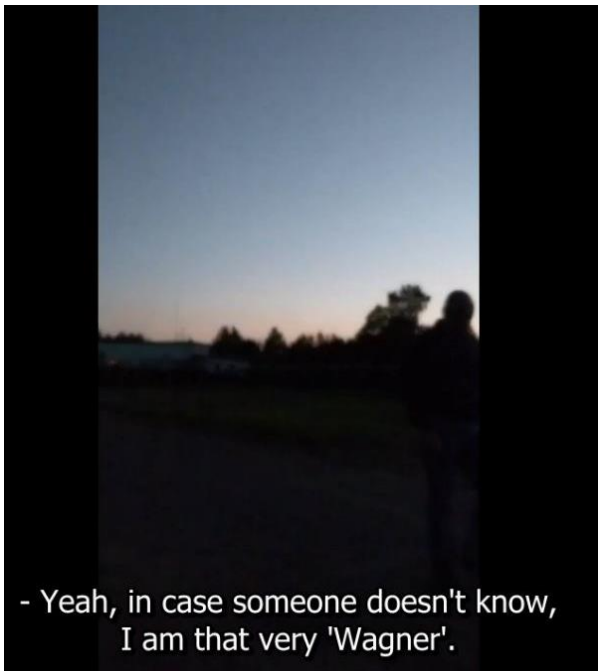

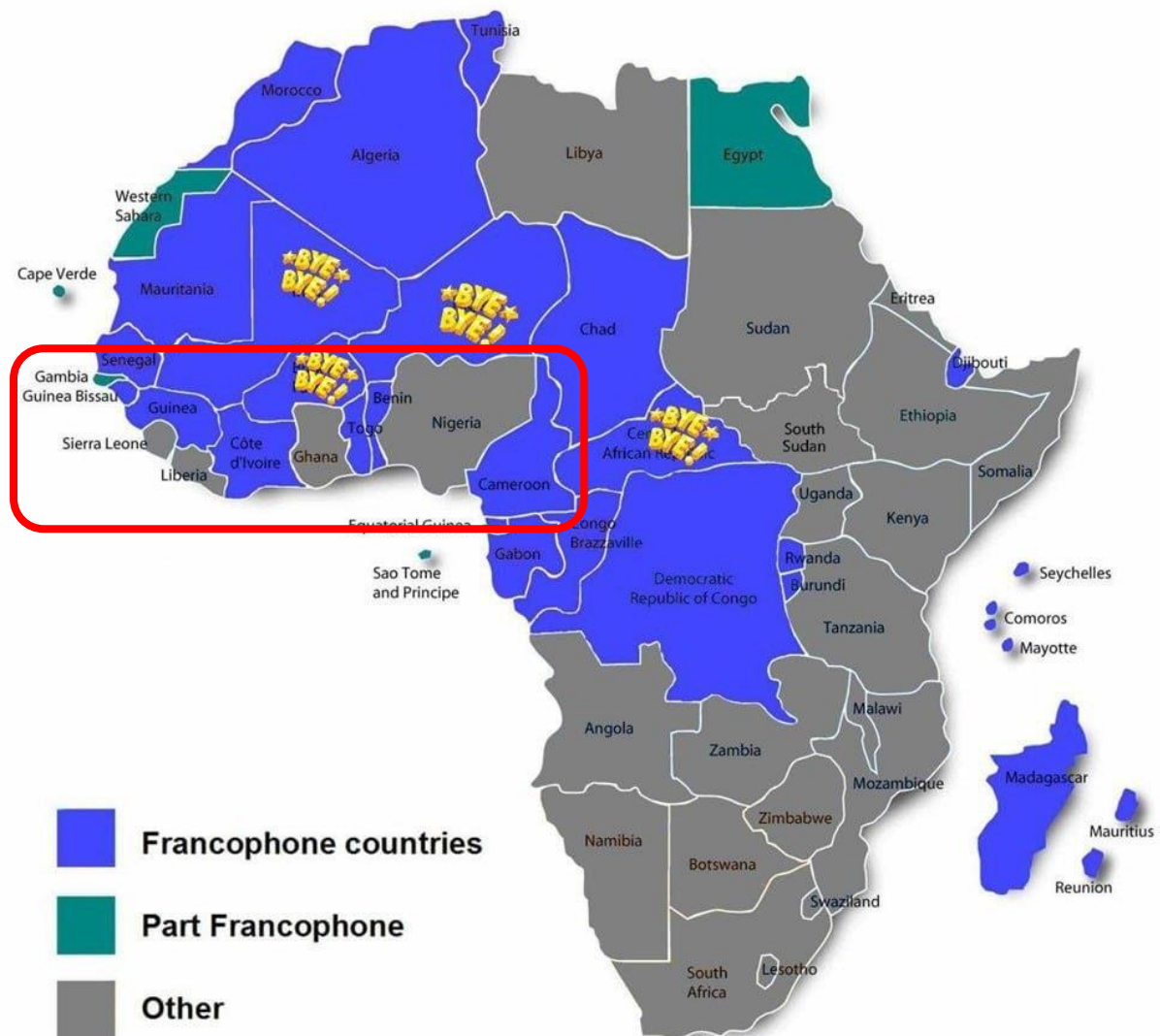


Figure 13 - Wagner, a God given **“BYE-BYE!”** vaccine against neo-colonial subjugation

from having partnered too closely with the state and the emerging trading classes. Through this collaboration, what had been heresy became orthodoxy.

In the Introduction to her book, *Empire of Guns: The violent making of the Industrial Revolution*, Priya Satia poses some questions arising from a standoff which suddenly developed between Samuel Galton Jr., the leading gunmaker in Birmingham, and the the Society of Friends, or Quaker Church, of which he was a leading member, which her book seeks to answer:

... Galton saw himself as part of a military-industrial society in which there was very little, if any, economic space outside the war machine and in which the paraphernalia of war doubled as the paraphernalia of civilization based on property. He took the Society of Friends' easy tolerance of his family business up to 1795 as evidence in support of his case. Was there any merit in Galton's view? Was Britain's emerging industrial economy actually a military economy? And if it was, why did the society of Friend's suddenly find that reality intolerable in 1795?²

She traces the roots of the turnaround in values to the events in America of 1776:

The American war raised the stakes of all these matters. In 1776, the radical author Thomas Paine, son of a Quaker, publicly accused the sect of hypocrisy in its criticism of American rebellion. Theirs were "pretended scruples": they exclaimed "against the mammon of this world" while "hunting after it with a step as steady as Time, and an appetite as keen as Death"³.

In that war, France had helped the American rebels prise Britain's biggest colony from its grip and, in turn, Britain had contributed to

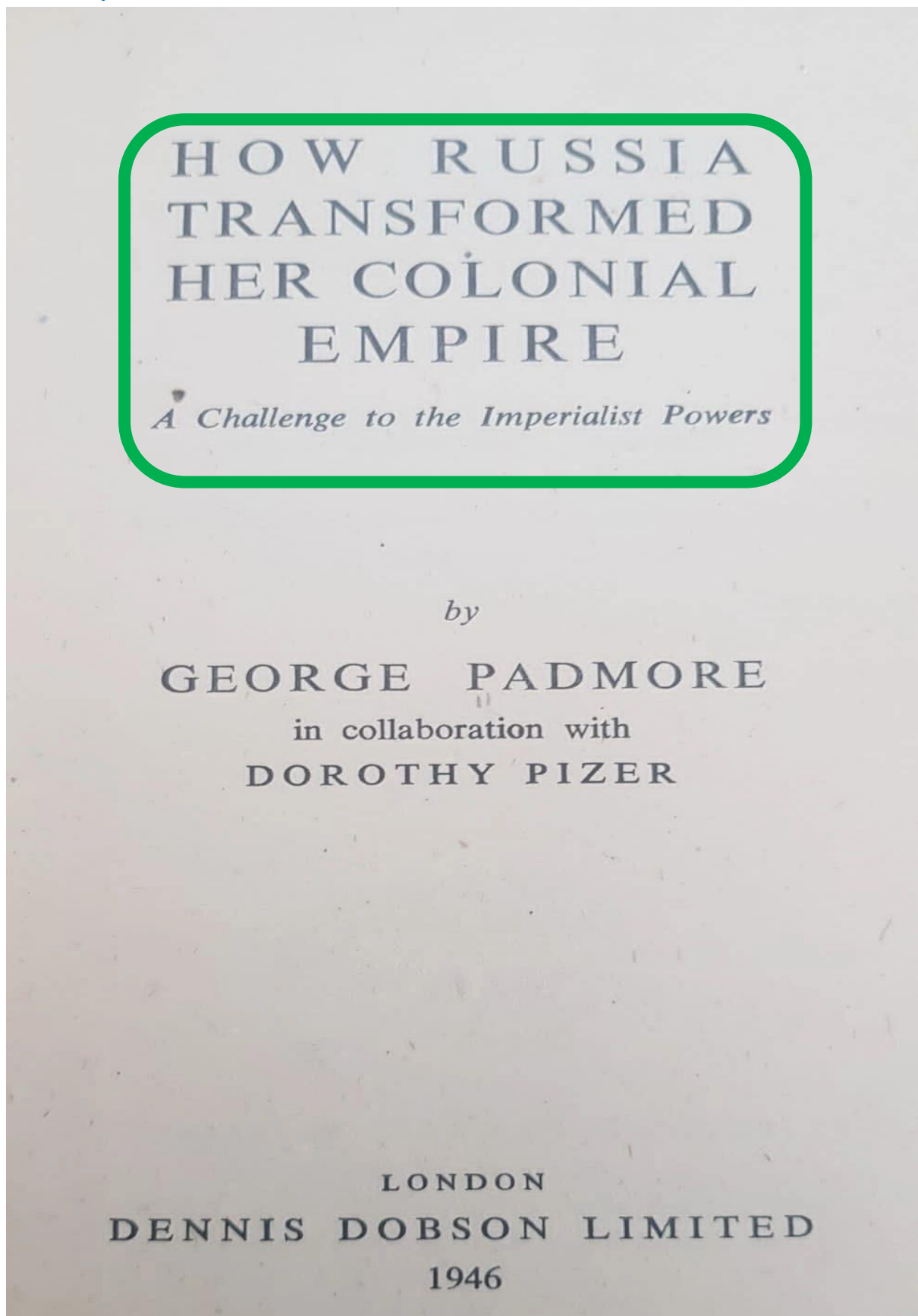


Figure 17 - The Russian Transformation a larger model of the [Orange Union](#) Transformation

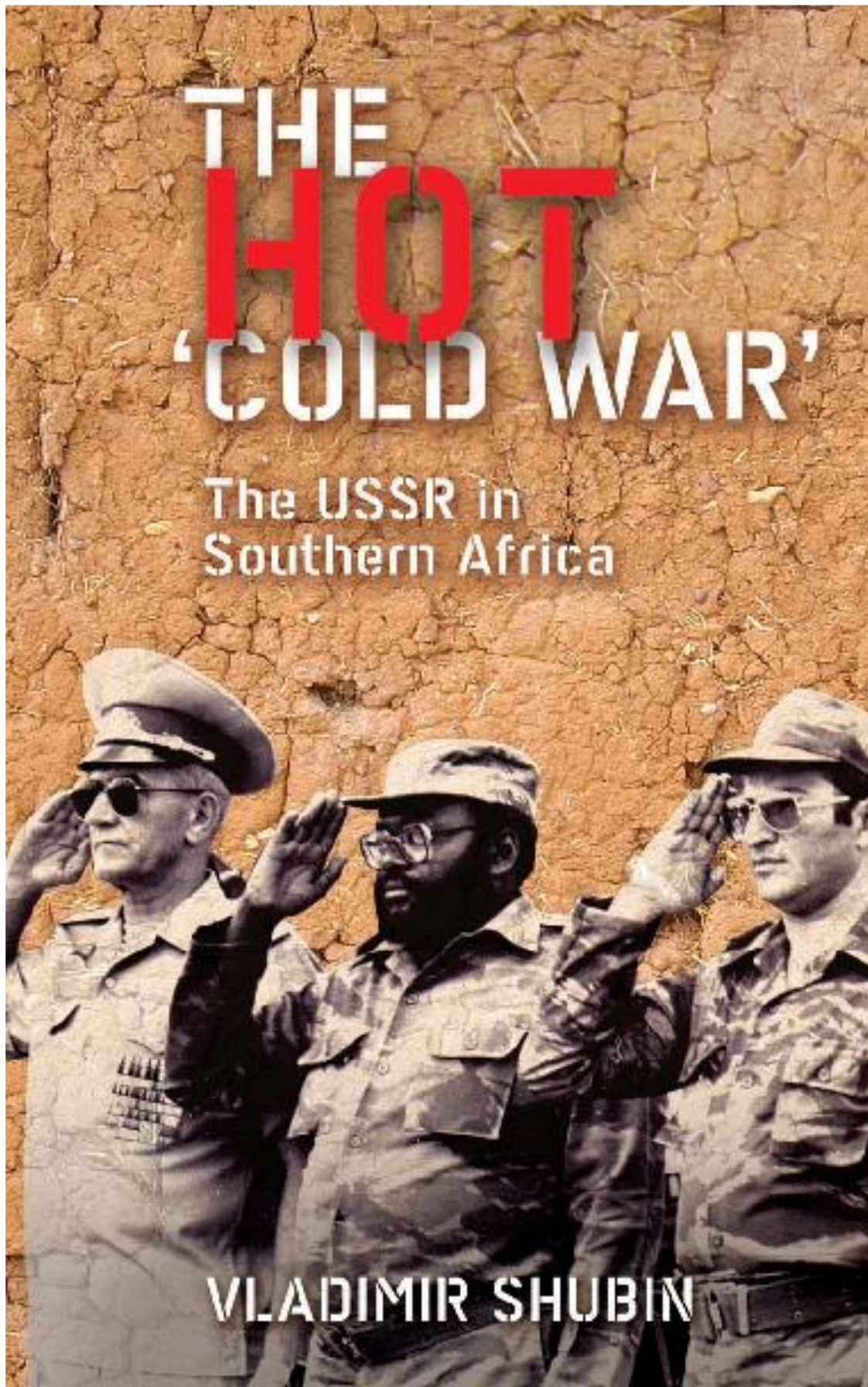


Figure 19 - Russia - A friend in need, A friend Indeed – A [reliable Partner in times of Affliction](#)

Historicising British and Russian Intervention during the Nigerian Civil War, 1967 – 1970

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Abstract

The desire of both the Biafran regime and the federal military government of Nigeria during the Nigerian civil war to secure diplomatic support as well as military assistance from the outside world could not but lead to the internationalization of the conflict. This desire coupled with other reasons attracted many countries to declare support and assistance to either the federal military government of Nigeria or the Biafran regime.

The focus of this paper is to give a historical analysis of the intervention of Britain and Russia during the Nigerian civil war. The motivational bases of their involvement in the war, the dynamics and levels of their involvement as well as the effects of such involvement shall be examined in this paper. The paper also argues in the conclusion that the refusal of Britain and Russia to comply with the call for international arms embargo in 1968 did not help in facilitating a peaceful resolution of the conflict. The paper also recommends as championed by scholars of conflict resolution in a civil war situation that there should be readiness by the intervening powers to stop arms sale when it might be effective to aid peaceful resolution of conflict.

Keywords: Historicizing, intervention, civil war, diplomatic support, military assistance.

1. Introduction

It is not unreasonable to briefly illuminate Nigeria's external relations with these powers (Britain and Russia) before the outbreak of the war so as to provide some understanding of subsequent developments. At independence, Nigeria in line with most developing countries of the world embarked upon a policy of non-alignment. The policy of non-alignment as practised by Nigeria and other non-aligned members can be understood from two perspectives. The first was to avoid political entanglement in the "Cold war". For instance, during issues involving the superpowers, the stand of Nigeria should be judged not by any obligation to either of the parties, but in the light of the merits or its implications on the international community. This stand was taken in order to resist external neo-colonial intervention in the internal affairs of Nigeria, as well as to give Nigeria the confidence to express its views on certain international issues. Furthermore, non-alignment made possible the diversification of sources of financial assistance. (Anglin, 1964).

In practice, the Nigerian policy of non-alignment was in line with the policies and aspirations of the western industrialised countries. Because of Nigeria's historical evolution, post independence era was highly committed towards establishing firm relations with Britain and its western allies. Before the civil war, in terms of aid received from foreign countries, it has been asserted that virtually all aids received were directly from western sources, especially Britain and the U.S.A or indirectly through the World Bank and the United Nations (Ate, 1980). During the same period, the Nigerian government "rejected from the Soviet Union a soft loan of £20 million (about ₦40 million) at two percent (2%) interest as against 2.8% from the western countries (Adegbonmire, 1970).

In terms of investment, Anglin (1964) explains that while "eighty percent (80%) of the £200 million in overseas investments in Nigeria was British the balance, apart from some Lebanese and Indian Capital, is also western". The figure for the Soviet bloc was low.

This strong sentiment in favour of the western countries was reinforced by the military factor. Indigenous officers of the army, air force and the police force were products of institutions like the Mons officer Cadet School, Aldershot, Sandhurst, Warminster, Scotland yard and others all in Britain. Britain and the United States also supplied the equipment for the navy and the army. This situation reached a climax with the signing of the Anglo-Nigerian Defence pact. Under this agreement, the Nigerian government was to make staging and tropicalization facilities available for the British government. In view of the fact that Britain is a member of NATO, the threat posed to Nigeria's international image engendered stout opposition from various members of the country especially students of the university College, Ibadan, and the members of opposition in government, which forced the Federal Government to abrogate the agreement in January, 1962. According to Ajibola (1978), despite the abrogation of the treaty, the spirit of the pact still lingered on as Britain continued to train most of Nigeria's military personnel, and until 1964, the commanders of the Navy and Army were British nationals. In the cultural and education sphere, Britain remains the most important external factor in Nigeria. English is the official language of the country and the educational institutions still exhibit traits of British influence. Britain remained the major overseas centre of learning for Nigerians. In contrast to this situation, Russian literature was banned in Nigeria by the Balewa regime. (Ajibola, 1978).

Thus, it is clearly evident from the above survey that in the field of international politics in general,

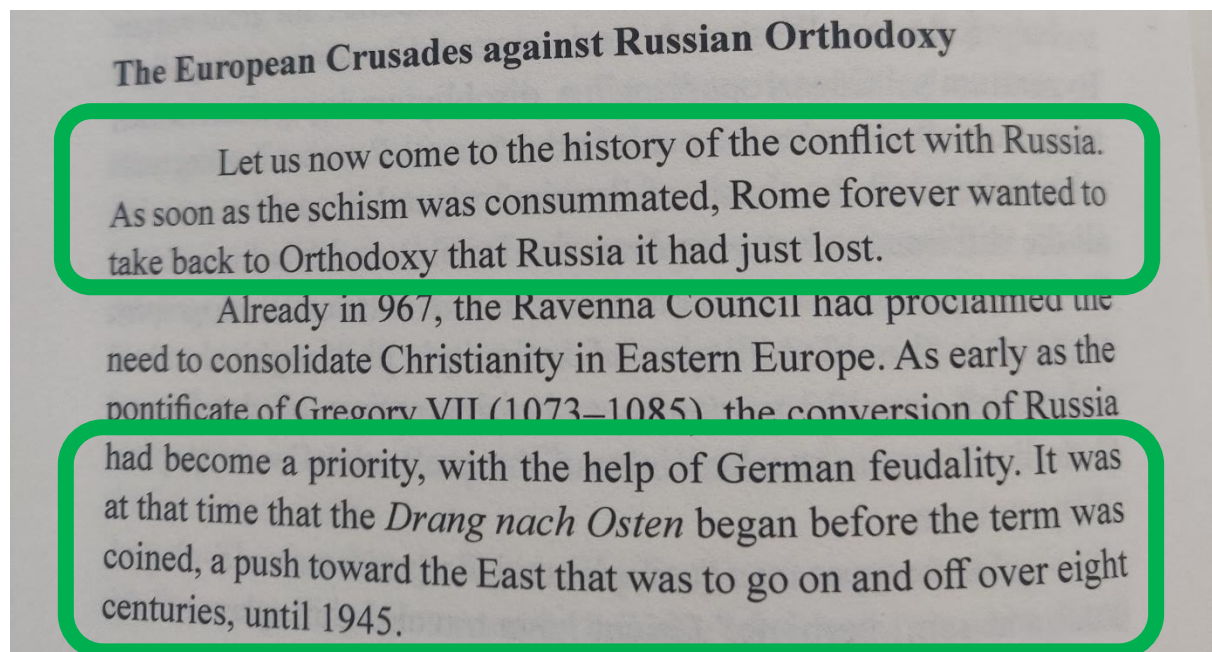


Figure 21 - As it was in the beginning.....

Subjugation by disingenuous omission and vindictive egregious commission

There is cross-country empirical evidence that the pre-requisite for good governance is a homogeneous, or majority ethno-linguistic group in a society. This is because it is easier to achieve political consensus in a society with a homogeneous or majority ethno-linguistic group than in a society where there is no majority ethno-linguistic group. Difficulty in achieving political consensus in a society leads to conflict, political instability, corruption and bad governance. This is the current state of many African countries due to colonialism, because many African states are composed of many ethnic groups that were bound together unnaturally by the colonialists. Furthermore, continued neo-colonialism is due to the underdevelopment of Africa that arises from the colonial configuration of many African states.

Russia cannot remain a strong ally of Africa for long if Africa remains in its present politically-unstable and corrupt state. A politically-unstable Africa, with its many corrupt governments today, is the reason why Africa is turning away from the West toward Russia. If Russia does not help Africa become politically-stable, with good governance, in the next decade or two, Africa would turn away from Russia, just as Africa is turning away from the West today.

The IMF is, indeed, notorious in Our Now. Since the 1970s, it has loaned money to bankrupt countries on terms that are the equivalent of debt bondage for their citizenry. Typically, when a country in Africa, Latin America or more recently Europe could no longer repay its government debts to foreign bankers, the IMF would step in to loan the money on neo-colonial conditions: wholesale transfer of public property to the international oligarchy, school and hospital closures, cuts in pensions and wages below the poverty line for the majority. Wherever the IMF visited, it left behind a black hole filled with pain.

By contrast, according to Eve, the IMP was not in the business of lending money. With private bankers gone, the world had no use for a cruel international bailiff, which is what the IMF had turned into; the IMP's remit was on the one hand to stabilize the world economy, and on the other to invest money directly in the regions of the world that needed it to develop, but without indebting them.

For decades, some countries in Our Now have been net exporters, while others have been net importers. For example, Germany has always exported far more to Greece and many

The Nigerian economic subjugation case study

Is the Naira a currency used for international trade that it should be floated? All that the floating of the Naira has done for 36 years now has been to keep us in the same illusion created through SAP that a country which produces little that is exportable with its local currency (like the Naira) for exchange with the rest of the World, can somehow, must somehow, sell the Naira for forex \$s by floating it. Meanwhile, we are without a viable manufacturing industrial base in Nigeria. All that floating the badly depreciating Naira (which does not sell exports in Naira) does is to keep expanding IMPORTS, and mainly deepening dependency on imports of non-essentials, luxury and fancy goods to mesmerize the poor.

The Oil we export is not produced in Naira but in Dollars, so why float the Naira whilst oil is sold in Dollars? Without an export oriented industrial base it is foolhardy to float your currency and then hope to somehow develop your manufacturing capacity at the same time. The industrial base is the foundation for value-added economic output and export. Which value-added products are we exporting from Nigeria? We stopped adding value to our Oil and only export it as crude. **Cocoa is the biggest Non-Oil Export produced in Naira and it is exported raw because there are few competitive processing factories in the country. But why is this so? Because of the high cost of the forex with which to buy and install the machines and spare parts needed for its processing.** And that's why it's contributing such a small fraction of forex earnings compared to Oil & Gas. And the more raw Cocoa we push into the World market the more depressed will be the price of cocoa.

The **European neo-colonial masters set us up for this losing strategy in every major commodity in order to keep us where they want us to be.** And we have not found a way to end the vicious circle in forty years. All value-added (processed/manufactured) goods need Machinery of various kinds: to generate cheap electricity for running our factories), Tools/Equipment to produce the goods from local raw materials, machinery to transport them to the Ports for export, and ships for shipping them abroad. All of these machines are produced, not in Naira, but in Forex \$, £, etc. Why first devalue the Naira to import all those types of Machines mentioned above which you will use to manufacture the goods? **How can you be competitive that way in exports, except you want to be a permanent producer and exporter of raw materials, raw human talent as we have been doing since industrialization was effectively halted with SAP and massive devaluations of the Naira starting from 1986?**

The Nigerian economy's foundation pillars are broken, and you can't build sound structures on bad foundation pillars. What are the foundation pillars of an economy? These are the structures of Production, Distribution and Consumption. Production technology is all about Machinery. You must get them in cheap, then power them with cheap Electricity, get cheap Raw Materials, cheap Transportation and handling, backed up by relatively cheap, skilled, efficient and educated Labour to compete favourably with World. This is what is fundamentally amiss with these policies and why they have never worked.

What has worked? What the few countries like China with the leadership, wisdom and courage which have broken free that Cul de sac have done is to have both a Local Yuan and a Foreign Yuan (RMB) currencies, each type partitioned to do two different but related things. You can't use the Local Yuan to buy a foreign goods, only the Exchangeable Yuan will do that. They developed an efficient manufacturing base all the way from the Skills taught and certified by their Colleges to all the types of Machinery earlier mentioned. They disallowed the kind of massive stealing going on in Nigeria and anyone who did betray the country paid dearly. They built massive infrastructures, having created the machine building industries at home to copy and reproduce what they brought

from the West. Their Diaspora scientists remain productive and patriotic to bring their knowledge and skills back home, etc.

Lastly, and most importantly, in this world of globalisation to the detriment of many for the benefit of a few, by disciplined coordination of the economy, they ensured that no one could force wrong policies on their country. Furthermore, where local costs have grown due to consistent rise in income for workers as in China, they moved their production of less competitive production outside to cheaper zones and enforced the same discipline there.

defeats. Both always left and still leave employers exclusively in positions to (1) receive and dispense their enterprises' profits and (2) decide and direct what, how, and where their enterprises produce. Those positions gave capitalists the financial resources and power—politically, economically, and culturally—repeatedly to outmaneuver and repress labor and the left.

Third, to newly organized versions of a New Deal coalition or of social democracy, we must add a new element. We cannot again leave capitalists in the exclusive positions to receive enterprise profits and make major enterprise decisions. The new element is thus the demand to change enterprises producing goods and services. From hierarchical, capitalist organizations (where owners, boards of directors, etc., occupy the employer position) we need to transition to the altogether different democratic, worker co-op organizations. In the latter, no employer/employee split occurs. All workers have equal voice in deciding what gets produced, how, and where and how any profits get used. The collective of all employees is their own employer. As such an employer, the employees will finally protect and thus secure the reforms associated with the New Deal and social democracy.

We could describe the transition from capitalist to worker co-op enterprise organizations as a revolution. That would resolve the old debate of reform versus revolution. Revolution becomes the only way finally to secure progressive reforms. Capitalism's reforms were generated by the system's impacts on people and their resulting demands for change. Capitalism's resistances to those reforms—and undoing them after they happened—spawned the revolution needed to secure them. In that revolution, society moves beyond capitalism itself. So it was in the French Revolution: demands for reform within feudal society could only finally be realized by a social transition from feudalism to capitalism.

- ❖ Russia to look for an abandoned town, city or province into which it will allow West Africans who meet certain educational standards to come to stay for a period of 6 – 18 months to get a better understanding of how they can make use of Russian heavy industry to build tools, machines and technologies that can both solve West African problems, and also establish new markets for goods and services that are locally available in West Africa.
- ❖ Encourage Russian cloud service providers like [Yandex Cloud](#), [VK Cloud](#), [Selectel](#) etc., to aggressively enter into the cloud market in West Africa. The key area of growth is getting the abundant IT talent in West Africa to help to domesticate Russian local government IT solutions for use in West Africa. Another area would be repurposing, rehosting and reengineering of big software solutions that were developed by the Communists for reuse to solve issues within West Africa. It is no secret that the existing solutions from the likes of Microsoft, Google, Apple etc. have been infused with algorithms that induce skewed results – ChatGPT being their latest and most insidious form of information manipulation.
- ❖ Grant [Igboho](#), [Grandson](#) and [Kanu](#) honorary citizenship of both Russia and Belarus. Then sit back and watch the entrenched system un-configure and reconfigure itself on its own to deal with such a profound intrusion into the currently entrenched malfeasant rule by proxy (that the existing system currently thrives by).

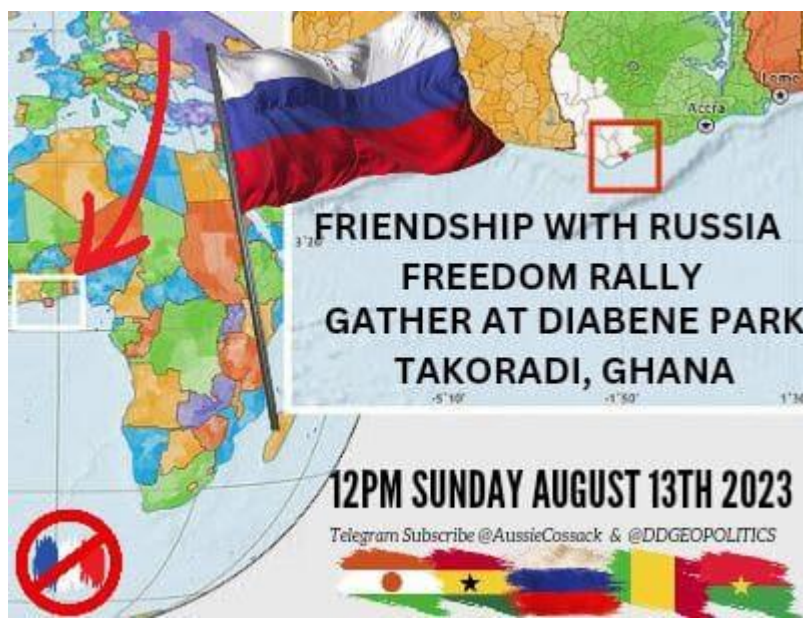


Figure 30 - *Солидарност със Русия!*
