The Five Pillars

Pillar	Promise
I. Energy Affordability & American Power	Powering the next American economy through affordable, reliable, American-made energy.
II. American Jobs & Opportunity	Building a new private-sector jobs ecosystem centered on manufacturing, innovation, skilled trades, and emerging technology.
III. Small Business First	Restoring Main Street opportunity and empowering entrepreneurs.
IV. Safe Communities & Secure America	Strengthening public safety, border security, infrastructure protection, and national resilience.
V. American Health Freedom	Affordable care, more choices, stronger families, and greater freedom.

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Pillar I: Energy Affordability & American Power

Powering America's Future

Affordable energy is the foundation of a strong economy. America cannot lead the world if we cannot power the world. This pillar lowers long-term energy costs, strengthens the grid, expands advanced nuclear energy, and creates high-paying American jobs.

American Grid Modernization Act	Modernize aging electric infrastructure so America can meet rising demand from AI, data centers, manufacturing, and households.	• Upgrade substations and transmission capacity • Strengthen grid reliability and resiliency • Harden infrastructure against cyber and physical threats • Improve permitting coordination for critical upgrades
Strategic Transformer Manufacturing Act	Reduce America's dependence on foreign transformer production and strengthen the energy supply chain.	• Domestic transformer manufacturing incentives • Strategic reserve for critical grid components • Buy American preferences for critical equipment • Supply-chain security reviews

Key Message: America cannot have an economic comeback without an energy comeback.

Pillar II: American Jobs & Opportunity

Creating Opportunity for Every American

The American Dream depends on good jobs, upward mobility, and an economy that rewards hard work. This pillar rebuilds private-sector opportunity through manufacturing, skilled trades, AI readiness, apprenticeships, and American innovation.

Skilled Trades & Apprenticeship Advancement Act	Expand pathways into high demand careers through apprenticeships, trade schools, workforce partnerships, and skilled trades training.	• Apprenticeship tax incentives • Trade school partnerships • Workforce pipeline development • Skilled trade recruitment
AI Workforce Readiness Act	Prepare American workers for the AI economy so AI becomes a tool for productivity, not a reason to leave workers behind.	• Community college AI certifications • Workforce retraining grants • AI literacy and productivity programs • Public-private partnerships for emerging technology careers
Nuclear Workforce Development Act	Train the next generation of nuclear engineers, operators, technicians, electricians, welders, and skilled trades workers.	• Community college and apprenticeship partnerships • Veteran transition pathways • Scholarships for nuclear and energy careers • Workforce pipelines tied to SMR deployment

Key Message: Government does not create prosperity; people do. This agenda is designed to unleash American workers, American businesses, and American innovation.

Pillar III: Small Business First

Empowering Main Street

Small businesses create jobs, strengthen neighborhoods, and give families a pathway to ownership. This pillar puts Main Street ahead of Washington bureaucracy and gives entrepreneurs room to grow.

Made in America Procurement Act	Give American small businesses a fair shot at federal contracts.	• Increase small business set-asides • Domestic sourcing preferences • Anti-fraud and transparency provisions • Fair access for Main Street suppliers

Key Message: The American Dream was built by hardworking Americans willing to take a chance, start a business, create jobs, and build a better future for their families.

Pillar IV: Safe Communities & Secure America

Protecting What Matters Most

Freedom and opportunity cannot flourish without safety and security. This pillar strengthens public safety, secures the border, fights fentanyl, protects critical infrastructure, and defends America from foreign and domestic threats.

Safe Communities Act	Give local law enforcement the tools and resources needed to reduce violent crime and strengthen community trust.	• Support local law enforcement • Officer wellness programs • Community policing partnerships • Technology modernization grants
Secure Border & Immigration Enforcement Act	Restore control of the border while modernizing legal immigration.	• Strengthen operational border security • Enhanced technology and surveillance • Expanded immigration court capacity • Deportation priority for violent criminal offenders • Strengthened E-Verify
School Safety & Youth Protection Act	Strengthen school safety while addressing root causes of violence.	• School security grants • Mental health resources • Federal-state law enforcement support and coordination • Threat assessment programs
Critical Infrastructure Protection Act	Protect America’s essential infrastructure from cyber, physical, and foreign threats.	• Protect critical infrastructure from cyber and physical threats • Expand public-private threat intelligence sharing • Modernize infrastructure security standards • Strengthen continuity and recovery planning for essential services

Key Message: The first responsibility of government is to protect its people so every family can live, work, and pursue the American Dream in safety and peace.

Pillar V: American Health Freedom

Affordable Care. More Choice. Better Outcomes.

Healthcare is personal. Americans deserve lower costs, more choices, price transparency, protection for preexisting conditions, and healthcare decisions that remain between patients, families, and doctors.

Interstate Healthcare Choice Act	Allow Americans to purchase health insurance across state lines where appropriate.	• Expand consumer options • Increase competition • Encourage lower premiums • Support plan portability
Health Savings Account Expansion Act	Empower families to control more of their healthcare spending.	• Increase contribution limits • Expand eligible expenses • Improve portability • Provide family flexibility
Primary Care Access & Telehealth Act	Expand access to primary care and telehealth services.	• Permanent telehealth protections • Direct primary care expansion • Provider shortage solutions • Support rural and underserved communities
