RTM in group problem solving, learning becomes an active and involved constructive process...

ADVANTAGES... In using Dewey's RTM

#1 **Group decisions** are usually better decisions than decisions made by individuals.

#2 Analysis of a problem is broader and more thorough.

DISADVANTAGES... of Dewey's RTM process...

#1 Group decision makes takes more time.

#2 Groupthink!

Dewey's Reflective Thinking Process "RTM"

- #1 Recognize the Problem
- #2 Describe and Analyze the Problem
- #3 Discover and Discuss Possible Solutions
- #4 Evaluate the Best Solution
- #5 Except or Reject the Proposed Solution

Alternative Problem-Solving Methods

Functional Theory Approach = adds evaluating every proposed solution

OR

The Single Question Format = five step process from a single question
