1.0 Introduction	It takes only a second to cause irreparable damage to the eye. However risks can be reduced , if not completely eliminated, by taking simple precautions and by the wearing of suitable eye protection

2.0 Main Points	
2.01	You have a legal obligation to use the eye protection provided in accordance with the current regulations
2.02	You must ensure that all eye protection provided is in good condition prior to, and during, wearing. You must also ensure that it fits comfortably, does not impair your sight or vision, and that it is suitable for the job you are doing.
2.03	Look after and maintain all protection. Keep it clean and report any damage or loss instantly.
2.04	Never use damaged equipment.

3.0 Points to Remember	
3.01	Even if not carrying out works which are assessed as hazardous to your eyes, you may be at risk from other operations nearby. Therefore always keep your eye protection with you, and if in any doubt at all, wear it!!!
3.02	Eye protection is provided specifically for the eyes. It is useless when worn around the neck or on the head!
3.03	Never carry out any work unless wearing suitable eye protection in the correct manner.
3.04	If you get something in your eye or suspect any form of eye injury including blurred vision etc. seek the help of a trained first aider.
3.05	Always consider your eyes when working in and around; plant and equipment (particularly power tools and cartridge fired tools), compressed air; hazardous substances; dust; aerosol spray; hand tools etc.
