
Dear Dr. Cole:

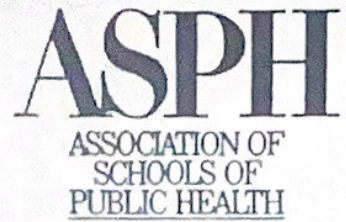
