Contest and DX Group

The TEAC Contest Group met by Zoom on 4/28/2Ø21. There were several members in attendance. We had a short discussion as May/June is a lull in the usually busy contest calendar. The next meeting is Wednesday, June 2 at 19ØØ CDT. Note that the meeting is moved from 18ØØ to 19ØØ to accommodate member requests.

The group has now entered 3 ARRL contests as a club, <u>ARRL November Sweepstakes – Phone</u>, the <u>ARRL 1Ø-Meter Contest</u>, and the <u>ARRL</u> <u>International DX Contest - Phone</u> with the minimum 3 log submissions. We also entered the <u>CQ WPX Phone Contest</u> with the minimum 4 logs, and the Spring SSB Sprint as a team called <u>The Nixie Tubes</u>. Two teams attempted separate activations for the <u>Texas State Parks on the Air</u> contest but band conditions were miserable and no logs were submitted.
