Slate Belt Chamber of Commerce Nomination & Election of Directors

The following individuals have been nominated for the open positions on the Slate Belt Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors. There are a total of 15 directors and roughly half are elected every year to a two year term. This term will begin on January 1, 2025.

The nominating committee, consisting of Paul M. Donovan Jr., Chairman, & Rosemary Albert have placed the preceding seven names into consideration for the eight available seats. Nominations will also be accepted from the general membership until November 6, 2024. Nominations must be received by that time to provide the committee an opportunity to confirm the nomination and to confirm that the nominated individual is willing to serve if elected. Any chamber member in good standing is eligible for nomination.

The election of Directors will be held at the December 16, 2024 holiday dinner. In the event there are no other nominations, a motion will be made that Paul Donovan be directed to cast a vote for the Slate of Directors as presented. This is in following Roberts Rules of Order where there are a specific number of candidates for the same specific number of positions. Technically there is no contest and the ballot is elected with the Chairman's vote. This will be voted on by those members in attendance that evening.

If there are additional nominations, a ballot of those in attendance will be taken that night and the seven highest number of votes will be awarded the first seven director positions. In the event of a tie for the eighth position, a ballot between those that are tied will determine the winner. 
