

Class Descriptions

Here's a brief description of the different classes.

Halter

 Walk and trot where the judge can see movement, then will come around to look at confirmation

Showmanship

- Complete a pattern, there will be walk, trot, back up and pivot.
- Competitor will set up horse for judge to inspect
- Pattern will be provided

Hunter

- Jumping pattern
- Horse will complete a jumping course of 4 to 6 jumps

Hunter Gambler's Choice

- Jumping course
- Each jump will be worth points (10-50) based on difficulty
- Competitor and horse will be timed to complete as many jumps within that time frame
- Competitors can do any jump of choice, however, cannot do the same jump twice in a row. There must be a jump between

• In Hand Trail

- Trail course
- Pattern will be provided

• In Hand Trail Gambler's Choice

- In hand obstacle course
- Each obstacle will be worth points (10-50) depending on difficulty
- Competitor and horse will be timed to complete as many

- obstacles within the time frame
- Competitors can do any obstacle of choice; however, cannot do the same obstacle twice in a row. There must be a different obstacle between.

- Cart required
- Obstacle course
