

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

We take the safety of our members and guests extremely serious. You can't enjoy blacksmithing from a hospital room.

Because of this, we have instituted several rules that you should know about. In fact, you will be required to sign a liability waiver acknowledging them if you come to our meeting!

1. If you are under 18, eye protection is mandatory. If you are an adult, it's HIGHLY recommended.
2. Boots or leather shoes are recommended.
3. Don't wear synthetics, they melt and stick to skin. Cotton and other natural fibers will burn, but they don't stick..
4. Reckless and or thoughtless acts will get you asked to leave.
5. If you bring a young person, YOU are responsible for them!
6. If you are not SURE of what you are doing... DON'T DO IT. Ask for help.
7. Gloves are a personal choice, there are lots of opinions on this, listen and choose.
8. There will be smoke, if you have asthma or any other breathing issue, be aware of the hazards.
9. ALL electric and or hydraulic equipment is off limits until you are trained on it.
