I-84 West to Exit 67. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Route 31 north. At the next set of lights turn right onto Route 30 (Hartford Turnpike). Tolland Agricultural Center grounds are app. 0.25 mile on the right directly past the Rockville Bank.

Turn left onto Cider Mill Rd., 0.6 miles to Boston Turnpike Rte.44 & 6. Turn left, go 0.3 miles to top of hill. On left, next to Comcast Cable.
