I-84 West to Exit 67. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Route 31 north. At the next set of lights turn right onto Route 30 (Hartford Turnpike). Tolland Agricultural Center grounds are app. 0.25 mile on the right directly past the M&T Bank.

From show: Left onto Route 30, go 2.3 miles to Tunnel Rd. Turn left onto Tunnel Rd., 1.8 miles to Lake St. Turn left onto Lake St., 1.5 miles to Cider Mill Rd. Turn left onto Cider Mill Rd., 0.6 miles to Boston Turnpike Rte.44 & 6. Turn left, go 0.3 miles to top of hill. On left, next to Comcast Cable.
