- Keyport residents may apply for one plot per household.
- The annual fee is \$25.
- Garden plots (4' x 8') and are assigned as applications are received.
- Returning gardeners in good standing will be given priority until February 1st.
- You may only apply for one plot per application and will be notified by email if there are additional available plots.
- If you do not receive a plot, your check will be returned.
- Growing season is from March 1st through February 28th.
- Each gardener must provide 5 hours per year in service to the entire site, under the direction of the ESCG Committee. This is in addition to the time you spend tending your garden plot and adjacent path.
- Only organic methods are permitted.
- Communication is primarily done through email.

Please mail completed application package prior to March 1st to the above address with payment of \$25.00, <u>payable to the **Keyport Garden Club.</u> In check memo write ESCG. Please do not make check out to ESCG.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These <u>Rules and Regulations</u> are set forth to ensure the maintenance of a neat, productive garden area and to ensure a pleasant and safe environment for all persons in the gardens and neighboring properties. <u>Mission</u> - Elizabeth Street Community Gardens (ESCG) is dedicated to maintaining an organic community garden that provides education and beautification to the community and supplies food for its members. ESCG members maintain the grounds at the ESCG, working in a spirit of cooperation and fellowship. Our goal is to offer a safe and attractive environment to people desiring a place to learn and grow edible produce and flowers.

ACCESS: Each member will receive the access code to the gates after the application and payment are accepted. Members must secure the locks upon leaving. The ESCG may be accessed by members between dawn and dusk. No person is permitted in the ESCG after dusk or before dawn.

BEHAVIOR: Children must be supervised by adults. Pets are not permitted inside the garden. Smoking is not allowed. (Note that tobacco can spread tobacco mosaic virus to tomatoes, so smokers should wash hands after smoking and before entering the ESCG.) Alcoholic beverages are not allowed. When listening to music, use headphones or ear buds and maintain a volume that cannot be heard by others. When using a cell phone, be considerate of your neighbors and move to an unoccupied area.

COMMON AREAS: Members are required to keep all common areas neat and free of trash. Trash must be carried out, as there no trash receptacles. See also Weeding instructions below.

COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS: Each plot's gardeners are required to donate a combined 5 hours of labor per growing season, under the direction of the ESCG Committee. Such maintenance may include, but is not limited to spreading woodchips, weeding common areas, repairs and end-of-season clean up.

COMPOSTING: Currently there is no compositing at the ESCG, if this changes you will be notified with instructions.

GROWING SEASON: Growing season is from March 1st through February 28th.

HARVESTING: Members may only harvest crops and flowers from their own plot. Members are encouraged to donate excess crops on Tuesdays and Thursdays to the Community Church across the street.

ORGANIC METHODS: All gardening at the ESCG must be done using organic methods. No chemical fertilizers, herbicides, or pesticides may be used anywhere in the ESCG. No chemically treated wood (for borders stakes, etc.) may be used. No dyed wood chips or synthetic (i.e., rubber) chip-type mulch may be used.

NON-TRANSFERRABLE: Under no circumstances may plots be sublet or transferred to another party. Any Member who can no longer maintain their plot during the season must inform the ESCG Committee. Fees are non-refundable.

LIABILITY: All ESCG users and their guests agree to hold harmless the Keyport Garden club and Borough of Keyport for any liability, personal injury, damage, loss or claim that may result from using the garden.

PROHIBITED PLANTS: To prevent casting shade on a neighboring plot, structures, and plants taller than 6 feet (i.e., corn, tall sunflowers) are not permitted at ESCG. In addition, invasive plants are not allowed in the garden. In addition, cacti, castor beans, illegal, and poisonous plants are not permitted.

RENEWALS: Members-in-good-standing can choose to renew their membership, keeping the same plot. Renewal requests must be made in writing with payment by February 1st. If a member wishes to renew but wants a different plot, this can be accommodated if the plot becomes available.

STARTING AND PUTTING THE GARDEN TO BED: If a plot is not planted by June 1, the plot will be considered abandoned and will be made available to applicants on the waiting list. Members with unkempt plots will receive two warnings, one week apart. If the member does not respond or make improvements within 1 week of the second warning, his/her plot will be considered abandoned and will be forfeited. If a member expects to be away for some time, ask another member to water and weed for you. If you will be gone for 2 or more consecutive weeks during the growing season, please notify an ESCG Committee member in advance. No later than December 1, members must neaten their plots for the winter as per the direction of the ESCG committee.

TOOLS: Some tools – shovels, rakes, wheelbarrow, etc. are available to share and stored in the shed. Replace borrowed tools to the shed.

WATERING: The Committee will provide water and hoses. After using the water and hose, the member must wind up the hose, turn off water, and lock the spigot.

WEEDING: Members will remove weeds from the paths adjacent to their plots. Place weeds and other garden trimmings in DPW supplied leaf bags. When bags are full, they are to be placed outside the ESCG gate for DPW pickup. All other trash must be carried out, as there no trash receptacles.
