



Keyport GardenWalk Art Contest Rules



Contest Theme

Capture the beauty, color, and charm of gardens, flowers, nature, and the Bayshore, celebrating the unique spirit of the Keyport GardenWalk.

1. Eligibility & Entries

- One original entry per artist.
- Artwork must be the artist's own original work, the piece must not have won a previous Keyport GardenWalk Art Contest, and must not infringe on the copyrights or intellectual property rights of others.
- Artwork created using generative artificial intelligence (AI) is not eligible.
- Parental or guardian consent is required for artists under 18 years of age.

2. Submission Requirements

- Submit your artwork by March 1 on-line at <https://keyportgardenclub.com/art-contest>
- Entries must be submitted as a high-resolution JPEG (maximum 1600 pixels and 1 MB).
- Do not include any text, lettering, logos, signatures, dates, or watermarks on the artwork. Entries are judged anonymously, and identifying marks may result in disqualification.

3. Judging

- All entries will be judged anonymously.
- Creativity & Originality – 35%; Interpretation of the Theme – 30%; Artistic Skill & Composition – 25%; Overall Visual Impact – 10%.
- The judges' decision is final.
- The Keyport Garden Club reserves the right not to select a winner if no entry meets the contest standards or to disqualify any entry that does not comply with these rules.

4. Winner

- The winning artist will be notified by March 15.
- The winning artwork may be featured on the Keyport GardenWalk guidebook cover, posters, brochures, website, social media, and other promotional materials.

5. Artwork Rights

- By submitting an entry, the artist grants the Keyport Garden Club a non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to reproduce, publish, display, resize, and use the artwork for Keyport GardenWalk promotional and educational purposes, including printed and digital materials. Artist credit will be provided whenever practical.
