

Fripp Island Art Guild Guidelines for Student Works for 1st Annual Summer Fine Arts Show
"Reflections of Fripp" June 7, 2026

- Open to all high school or college students located in the Low-County
- Artworks should fit into the theme of 'Low-Country Life'
- Artworks should be family friendly
- Students are allowed to price their work for sale—commission free! (credit card processing fees and taxes will still apply)
- Students can enter up to two(2) artworks
- Entry fee is \$10
- Artworks will be juried into the show
- Acceptance announcements will go out no later than May 15th
- If accepted:
 - College student works are expected to be properly matted with neutral matboard and hanging wire/clip securely attached to the back.
 - High school work can be properly matted with neutral matboard and hanging wire/clip securely attached to the back. If without matting capabilities, please mount on black railboard and attach a hanging clip to back.
 - Attach copy of registration to back of artwork
 - Drop-off will be Saturday, June 6th between noon and 2:00PM
 - High school works ONLY can be arranged for earlier drop-off with local art teacher.
 - Pick-up will be immediately after the show Sunday, June 7th @ 5:00pm
 - High school works ONLY will be picked up by local art teacher to distribute back next school year
- Fill out registration before April 30th. All entries must be registered on-line. No walk-ins or late submissions.

 - Print once filled out for your own record and another to tape to back of work if accepted
