A few years ago, there were several online quilting bees. The way these "bees" worked was that each month a new Queen Bee was chosen. The Queen picked a block and the colors she wanted her block made in, and posted it to the group. Including a photo was helpful. The members of the group committed to making one block and sending it to the Queen. This continued for one year. At the end of the year, each member in the group had the opportunity to request and receive blocks to make a quilt of her choosing.

I spoke to Darrell about doing this as part of our guild after meeting sewing time. In the newsletter, the Queen/King could list the upcoming block and colors to use. After the meeting, the "Queen/King" could demo the block she would like made. Members have the option to then stay and make the block. If a Bee participant has to miss the meeting, it will be possible to make the block at home and bring it to the next meeting.
