CUP OF COMFORT QUILT BLOCK

MATERIALS:

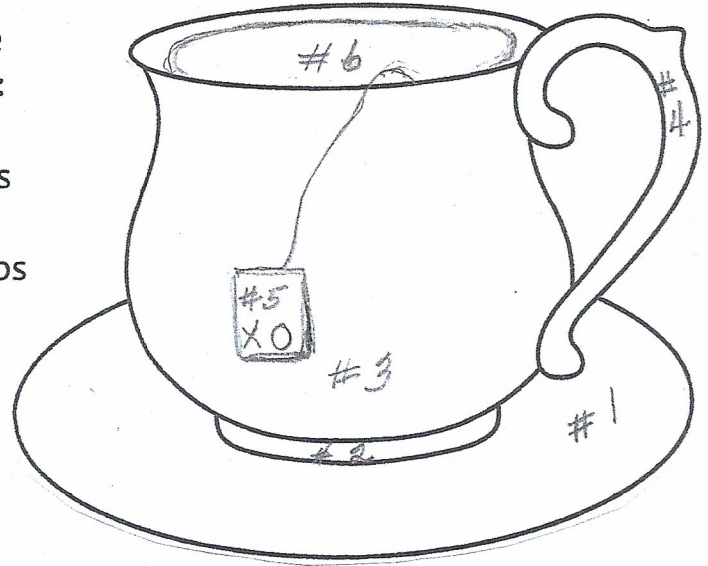
One 8-1/2 x 8-1/2" background square

Two scraps of coordinating material:

(1) Approximately 1-1/2" x 3 1/4"

(2) Approximately 7 x 5 (or scraps
To fit the templates)

Fusible web to use with the scraps



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Trace the pattern pieces onto the fusible web. Cut out each piece leaving about a 1/4" allowance around each piece (if hand sewing the cup)
2. Iron pattern pieces # 1 , 2 and #3 on larger piece of fabric. Pattern pieces #4 ,#5 and #6 traced onto other fabric. Cut the pieces on the drawn lines.
3. Iron the pattern pieces one at a time in their number order, #1 saucer, #2, # 3 cup and base, #4 handle, #5 name tag, and #6 tea.
4. Using your machine's decorative function blanket stitch around All the raw edges or (hand stitch if preferred)
5. Please return in the bag you received the pattern to Rusty Wall or Lorraine Patterson.
