Latinx Political Leadership Project

The Latinx Political Leadership Project (LP2) is a student fellowship program that will run from January 2022 through the November 2022 election. Students will learn about the history of Latinx political involvement in Colorado, the crucial contributions they have made, as well as well as the persisting obstacles to political engagement. Particular attention will be given to contemporary voting rights issues and initiatives. Students will then have the opportunity to plan and implement their own get-out-the-vote campaigns, working with local and state community organizations and leaders. Fellows who successfully complete the program will receive a \$500 stipend.

Who can apply: We are looking for highly motivated Latinx high school seniors or college students living in or from El Paso County, Colorado.

Program/Nime Commitment: Student fellows will meet 2-3 times per month in January through April, via zoom on Wednesday evenings. From May through October, fellows will meet as needed to plan and implement their get-out-the-vote campaigns.
