

COLONEL LOUIS S. LETELLIER SCHOLARSHIP

OFFERED BY THE CIVIL ENGINEERS CLUB OF CHARLESTON

The Club

The Civil Engineers Club of Charleston, a non-profit organization, is dedicated to the association of civil engineers and those professionals engaged in the practice of civil engineering. The Club is sponsored by voluntary contributions from companies, organizations, and individuals who recognize the importance of continuing education and training in the field of civil engineering.

The Scholarship

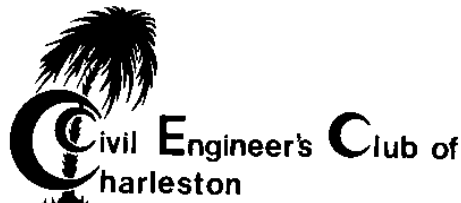
The number of scholarships and the dollar amount for each will be determined by the Club, but each scholarship will be not more than ***\$5,000 per semester and will not exceed 10,000 per year.*** These scholarships will assist and encourage qualified students to further or continue their interest in selecting civil engineering as a pending or continued career. For the 2022 scholarship, \$10,000 will be awarded.

The award may be supplemented by contributions in any amount from other individuals or organizations. These other contributions will be administered by the Club. Payments will be made directly to the college or university at the beginning of each term to be credited to the college account of the recipient. Students may reapply for scholarship consideration each year they are eligible.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

The application must be completed and emailed to the Club no later than ***Tuesday, March 22, 2022.*** Copies of the applicant's unofficial academic transcripts and all letters of recommendation and reference must also be received by the Club no later than ***Tuesday, March 22, 2022.***

Any student who is a permanent resident of Berkeley, Charleston or Dorchester County and is enrolled full-time in a civil engineering certificate or degree program at an accredited college or university in the State of South Carolina is eligible to apply for the scholarship. Relatives of the Club Scholarship Committee are not eligible for scholarships.



Scholarship Selection Criteria

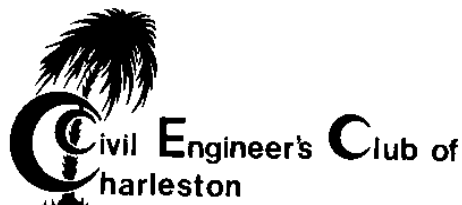
The selection of scholarship recipients will be determined by the Club, taking into consideration the following criteria.

- o The applicant's indication of interest in pursuing a career as a Civil Engineer.
- o The recipient(s) shall be entering his/her junior or senior college year for the **2022-2023** school calendar when initially awarded the scholarship. Award will be limited to two (2) successive college years for any one recipient, although not guaranteed based on yearly scholarship applications received. Applicants must reapply each year to be considered for the award.
- o The applicant's record of scholastic achievement, including grade point average.
- o The applicant's economic need. Certain tax and financial information may be requested.
- o The applicant's references and recommendations by instructors, employers, and other pertinent individuals, including the applicant's other scholarships.

Submittal Requirements

The applicant must submit the following by ***Tuesday, March 22, 2022:***

1. A typed, signed statement of the applicant's general activities and interests, anticipated employment (if any), your contemplated field of study, and the career you expect to follow. (Statement should not exceed 500 words in length and should be typed in concise form).
2. An outline of your proposed program of study to substantiate your intent to pursue an education in the field of civil engineering.
3. Unofficial copies of transcripts of all college courses that have been taken to date. Official copies (certified by the registrar) of college transcripts must be supplied upon award of scholarship.
4. Typed and signed letter of recommendation from at least two persons, such as the department head or Dean of the college, current or past employers, local professional civil engineering consultants, professional architect, industry contractors, etc. can submit a letter recommending the applicant. *It is preferred, but not required, that one of these letters be submitted by someone in the civil engineering industry.* The letters should be emailed directly to the Club Scholarship Committee and will be treated confidentially.

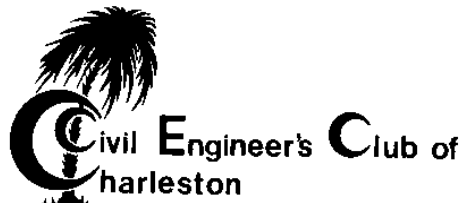
