Resolution 2026-047 – Earth Day Event at Thompson Mazzarella Park

The Earth Day event will be held on Saturday April 25 from 1:00 PM - 3:00 PM. The event will be free and open to all. The Earth Day event will include activities such as nature walks, native creatures talk, seedling plantings, children's activities and nature projects, recycling and composting information tables and more. The Town Recreation Department has been allocated a budget of \$2500 for the Earth Day event in the approved 2026 budget to pay for tent, table and chair rentals, wildlife demonstration, permit fees, and children's nature craft projects.

Resolution 2026-048 – Approve Interior Demolition of Cemetery Chapel

The TB approved the first phase of the plan to demolish the interior of the cemetery chapel, located on the corner of Route 9 and Mill Road. Supervisor Spinzia explained that it is the Town's plan to renovate the interior so that it can be used for meetings. Parking spaces will be made available at the site.

Resolution 2026-050 – Presentation of the Annual Historic Preservation Award

The Historic and Archaeological Preservation Advisory Committee (HAPAC) has nominated the Quitman House and Palatine Farmstead as this year's award recipient in recognition of their extraordinary achievements in the ongoing restoration, maintenance, and stewardship of this remarkable local historic resource. The award will be presented to Quitman House and Palatine Farmstead at the May 11th TB meeting.
