<u>Approval of Minutes</u>: Commissioner Brooks-Leete moves to approve regular meeting minutes from Tuesday, October 26 as written and Commissioner Hardin seconds. Motion passes.

<u>Voucher Review</u>: Commissioner Hardin moves to approve expense vouchers 9181-9205 in the amount of \$18,194.23 and Payroll transfer in the amount of \$42,096.31 for a total of \$60,290.54 and Commissioner Brooks-Leete seconds. Motion passes.

<u>Staff Reports</u>: Director Cochran discussed participation in the Chamber of Commerce drivethrough trick or treat, the Monster Splash swim, party rental prices, roof update, and boiler pump issues.

New Business:

- 1. Staff Vaccination: Commissioner Brooks-Leete makes a motion that all district staff be required to be vaccinated against Covid 19 by January 14, 2022, and Commissioner Hardin seconds. After discussion motion is defeated 1 to 3 with Commissioner Chargualaf voting yay and Commissioners Hardin, Brooks-Leete and Wiegenstein voting nay.
- 2. Superintendent Selection: Director Cochran gives an update on the School Board meeting attended as a private citizen. After discussion, it was agreed that any action taken would be as private citizens and not as the District Board.
- 3. Resolution 2021-10: Commissioner Hardin moves to approve Resolution 2021-10, North Whidbey Pool, Park, and Recreation District 2022 Budget as presented and Commissioner Brooks-Leete seconds. The process of obtaining liability insurance quotes for a possible savings and progress towards providing health care for the staff is discussed. Motion passes.
- 4. Resolution 2021-11: Commissioner Brooks-Leete moves to approve Resolution 2021-11 authorizing the increase in the regular property tax levy to be collected in the 2022 tax

- year, the dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount of the previous year shall be \$8,910.74 which is a 1% increase from the previous year and Commissioner Hardin seconds. After discussion motion passes.
- 5. 2022 Levy Certificate: Commissioner Chargualaf moves in accordance with RCW 84.52.020 that North Whidbey Pool, Park, and Recreation District do hereby certify to the Island County legislative authority that the Commissioners of said district request that the following levy amounts be collected in 2022 as provided in the district's budget, which was adopted following a public hearing held on November 16, 2021. General levy of \$1,400,693.00 and the administrative refund levy amount of \$837.06 and Commissioner Hardin seconds. Motion passes.
