How to mount your bike seat


NEEDED TOOLS

To start replacing your saddle, you will need only two tools: a hex wrench and a key.



(OPTIONAL) REMOVE THE OLD SADDLE WITH THE SEAT POST FROM YOUR BIKE

Remove the old saddle with the seat post from your bike. It is as simple as adjusting the seat height.



CASE 1 - TUBULAR SEAT POST

For tube style seat post mount your bike saddle with the adaptor directly on the post. (Figure 1)

- Put the bike saddle with the adaptor on the seat post.

Make sure you adjust the saddle angle by rotating the adaptor.

- Tighten the 2 lateral nuts until the saddle is fixed.



CASE 2 - BENT TOP SEAT POST

If your seat post has a little bent at the top like the one on (Figure 1)

- Remove the adaptor (Figure 3) from the new saddle
- Remove your old saddle
- Mount your new saddle rails on the seat post (Figure 2)
- Adjust the seat angle and tighten the screws



Saddle with no adaptor


