

2023 FLORIDA REPORT CARD

on Education, Housing & Health

Our evaluation is unique because it explains the effect of each law bill based on legislative research. Each Florida Legislator was rated (pass/fail) based on their voting record on issues in areas that matter to every Floridan: education, health, and housing.

Our data analysis allowed us to select laws/bills and provide the true an effects explanation of each law and the effects they will have on all Floridians regardless of socioeconomic status, religion, or race. Our report card focuses on fourteen (14) laws in education, health, and housing. Decisions were made by examining the influence, repercussions, and standards of living that each law has on all Florida residents.

Legislator's whose vote enhanced the quality of life of Florida residents received a thumbs up. Similarly, legislator's whose vote did not enhance the quality of life of Florida residents received a thumbs down.



	Education
HOUSE BILL 551 Require African American Instruction	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-103) amends s.1003.42, F.S. Requires school districts to provide evidence that requirements relating to the instruction of African American history are being met. Allows the Department of Education (DOE) to seek input from and contract with state or nationally recognized African American educational organizations to support curriculum on the history of African Americans. Requires school districts to submit to the Commissioner of Education (commissioner) and post on their website
	an implementation plan for required instruction topics. Allows the State Board of Education (SBE) to initiate compliance actions outlined in s. 1008.32(4), F.S. against school districts for failure to comply with implementation plan requirements.
HOUSE BILL 598 Higher Educational Facilities Financing	 (Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-92) amends s243.51, F.S., s.243.53, F.S., s.243.54 F.S., s.243.58 F.S., s.243.73 F.S. amends provisions related to the Higher Educational Facilities Financing Authority (HEFFA). Revises provisions relating to member appointments and meetings. Changes the voting requirement from a majority of members present in a meeting to the majority of members participating in the meeting. Expands the authority of the HEFFA to contract for services. Specifies that the HEFFA may not enter into a financing agreement for a project with a participating institution that is not financially responsible and fully capable of fulfilling the obligations at the time the agreement is executed.
CS/HOUSE BILL 733 Middle School and High School Start Times	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-78) amends s.1001.42, F.S. Requires that no later than July 1, 2026, the instructional day for all public and charter middle schools begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and no earlier than 8:30 a.m. for high schools. A charter school-in-the-workplace20 is exempt from this requirement.
SENATE BILL 7026 Higher Education Finances	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-95) Amends s.1001.706, F.S. Provides flexibility for state universities and Florida College System (FCS) institutions regarding the use of funds in areas relating to the use of carry forward fund balances, contracting for professional services, compensation of employees, including for bonuses, and the waiver of out-of-state fees for student athletes receiving an athletic scholarship.



Health

SENATE BILL 0612 Blood Clot & Pulmonary Embolism Policy Workgroup	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-192) Creates s. 408.0621, F.S. Citing this act as the "Emily Adkins Prevention Act"; requiring the Secretary of Health Care Administration, in conjunction with the State Surgeon General, to establish a blood clot and pulmonary embolism policy workgroup; requiring the secretary to submit a final report to the Governor and the Legislature by a specified date, etc.
HOUSE BILL 0721 Paid Family Leave Insurance	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-149) Amends s. 624.406, F.S. and creates s. 624.6086, F.S. Gives employers the option to offer, and authorizes life insurers to transact, paid family leave insurance providing benefits covering certain lost wages.
SENATE BILL 0736 Controlled Substances	(Laws of Florida Chapter2023-221) Amends s.893.03, F.S. Adds several potent synthetic opioids to the list of drugs considered to have to a high potential for abuse. Example of Schedule I drugs are: heroin, marijuana (cannabis), LSD, PCP, ecstasy, methaqualone, and peyote.
SENATE BILL 0768 Referral of Patients by Health Care Providers	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-251) amends s. 456.053, F.S., Removes the direct supervision requirement and the requirement that the physician be present in the office suite, allowing general supervision of such services from locations outside of the office where the services are provided.
SENATE BILL 2510 Health	 (Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-239) This bill affects several different Florida Statutes Increases the income threshold for each resident who receives a pension, compensation, or gratuity from the Federal Government, or income from any other source who resides in a State Veterans' nursing facility from \$130 to \$160 per month for his or her maintenance and support while a residence. s.296.37 F.S. Clarifies the premium paid under Florida Kidcare full pay programs. s.409.814, F.S. Increases the nursing home prospective payment reimbursement methodology for the Quality Incentive Program Payment Pool from 6 percent to 10 percent of the September 2016 non-property related payments of included facilities. s.409.908, F.S. Creates the Graduate Medical Education Slots for Doctors Program. s.409.909 (5), F.S Provides for a portion of the Statewide Medicaid Managed Care achieved savings rebate to be repaid to the federal government. s.409.908, F.S Establishes a Medicaid managed care pilot program to provide home and community-based services to individuals with developmental disabilities in Hardee, Highlands, Hillsborough, Manatee, Polk, Miami-Dade and Monroe counties (Medicaid regions D and I). s.409.9855, F.S Prohibits the Agency for Health Care Administration from requiring a home health agency to meet the requirements of Medicare certification, if a home health agency does not provide Medicaid skilled private duty nursing and attendant care nursing services, beginning October 1, 2021.



CS/SENATE BILL 102	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-17) Amends s.125.0103, F.S.
Housing	Effect of Bill: deleting the authority of local governments to adopt or maintain laws, ordinance, rules, or other measures that would have the effect of imposing controls on rents, etc.
HOUSE BILL 133	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023.181) Amends s. 83.491, F.S.
Fees in Lieu of Security Deposits	Authorizes landlord to offer tenant option to pay fee in lieu of security deposit; provides requirements relating to certain notices, filing of insurance claims, options for paying fee, & written agreements between landlord & tenant to pay fee in lieu of security deposit; prohibits landlord from accepting certain payments; specifies landlords have exclusive discretion whether to offer tenants such option; prohibits landlord from approving or denying application for occupancy based on prospective tenant's choice to pay fee in lieu of security deposit.
SENATE BILL 678	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-116) Amends s.337.25, F.S.
Disposal of Property	Allows the use of property as affordable housing qualifies as use for a public purpose in the context of the authorization of the Department of Transportation to convey property without consideration to a governmental entity, etc.
SENATE BILL 1417	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-314) Creates s.83.425, F.S.
Residential Tenancies	Expressly allows the state government (Governor) to regulate residential tenancies, the landlord-tenant relationship, and all other matters covered by the Act. · Specifies that it supersedes any local government regulations on matters covered under the Act. (ex: screening process used by landlords in approving tenancies, security deposits, rental agreement applications, and fees, terms and conditions of rental agreements and notice requirements)
SENATE BILL 7044	(Laws of Florida Chapter 2023-269) Amends s. 550.054, F.S.
Changes in Ownership of or Interest in Pari-mutuel Permits	Clarifies that a purchaser, transferee, or assignee of a valid pari-mutuel permits permit may be issued a pari-mutuel permit to be purchased, transferred, or assigned by a permitholder, if approved by the Florida Gaming Control Commission (commission) before such purchase, transfer, or assignment. Authorizes the issuance of an annual operating license to an eligible purchaser, transferee, or assignee of a valid PMW permit.
