# ANOTHER CHANGE!!!

The Alabama Emmaus Board of Directors had an on-site meeting at Camp on March 20 and did a walkthrough of the buildings. At that meeting, they were told that the Bishop of the North Alabama Conference had given the Camp permission to set its own protocols for those using its facilities. In turn, Executive Director Tony Jones has given the Alabama Community the right to set their own protocols for Walks. It had also been learned that if Walks were held in the Lodge, the dining room there would have to be open to the others who were also on campus. That created a privacy concern. Social distancing had also been an issue for eating areas, the Conference Room and the Pilgrims' Prayer Chapel. At the time of that meeting, distancing had been changed from 6' to 3'. In light of that, it was decided that the rooms always used in Hutto could now be used again. There is currently a maximum of 21 Pilgrims per Walk. This allows for the spacing in the Conference Room and the Chapel. And with 10 to 11 tables in the dining room, and only the Conference Room being seated, this will also work. Stay up to date! The next Board Meeting is May 1<sup>st</sup>, when the decision will be made regarding Walks in August!
