SPONSORSHIP 101

Since Walk #505 is from our Cluster Grouping, most of the team members will be. It's to be Sept. 22-25, so the team meetings are about to begin. This makes it a good time to remind us that no one who is serving in the Conference Room may sponsor a Pilgrim on that Walk. According to the Standing Rules, if your Pilgrim is assigned to this Walk, one of you is to be rescheduled. It is also true that a person serving in the Conference Room may not work there if a Pilgrim on that Walk is their family member, even if sponsored

by someone else. Those who are working on the back hall are strongly discouraged from having a Pilgrim on the Walk they are working. Pilgrims are to have their privacy. If they can see their sponsor throughout the day, this can be lost. It can also create in the Pilgrim a sense of having to meet the expectations of their sponsor. There's always a reason why things are the way they are, and these are some of them. So, in a spirit of cooperation and charity, please don't override the rules.
