Community Updates

The Annual Training Event was held at Camp Sumatanga August 9-10. Community Lay Director Butch Fennell reported that Walk #523, a Men's Walk, in progress that weekend had 16 Pilgrims in attendance. He noted that the two women's Walks in September and October had

more that 20 assigned and were in good shape. However, Walk #527 in November has only three Pilgrims at this point.

There has been a 40% decline in sponsorship since the COVID shutdown. Butch urged the sponsorship of younger people while noting the overall age of the Community. One good way to do this, if you have children over the age of 18, would be to sponsor them and ensure Emmaus is passed along to the next generation.
