As you may know, the Alabama Emmaus Community was asked by Camp Sumatanga to take responsibility for the refurbishing and updating of Hutto Auditorium since the COVID shutdown. This included repair of a leak in the roof near the Agape Room in 2021 and repair of banners in the Banner Room. Since then, new wooden doors downstairs and new glass doors upstairs in the entry have been installed. During this process there has been total cleaning of walls, chairs in the Conference Room, the Refreshment Room and the stage area. In addition, new chairs have been purchased for the auditorium as well as racks to store them. This week the board was notified that new gutters have been installed.
