Something that some groups have done over the years is have each member bring \$1 every week – or as often as the group meets. They have a `treasurer' who sets up an account and collects this money. There are often Ways these funds can meet needs at church, in the community, or among the group and/or their friends. It's a neat way to minister if your group would like to try it!



#### We all know an important part of being a sponsor is helping your Pilgrims find a Reunion Group. So first of all, will you consider asking them to join yours? Of course if yours is gender specific, that might not be a fit. But if that's not an issue, is there room in your group? If not, what's the next step? This is all pertinent if your Pilgrim is local. If not, this raises other issues. What do you do if your Pilgrim lives out of town, or even out of state? These are things to consider and to plan for before you ever even start the sponsorship process. When your Pilgrims are local, if

all women and your Pilgrim is a guy, of course you have the list the Cluster maintains. If a Pilgrim lives within the AEC, you can find all the Cluster Leaders on the AEC website. And if you have one from outside the area, online searches could possibly give you a contact. But sometimes this is very difficult. And because it is, it will require more shepherding from you to guide the Pilgrim through making contact with a Community nearby. And it may be that your Pilgrim will have to start a group on their own.
