The following suggestion is exactly that – it's just a suggestion. There are some Reunion Groups who bring a \$1 apiece to each meeting and build a fund to fill needs they see around them. This could be a family in need, a ministry, or any good deed the group would like to do. It is, of course not a part of the original design of an accountability group and is not required. It's just a thought.

SPONSORSHIP 101

It's a natural part of being a sponsor to be really excited about putting it all together. We all see a person that we want to `share the love' with, and regardless of how well we might know them, we offer them the chance to attend. Why does it matter how well we know them? For one thing, it's important to know who they know and who knows them in order to gather the letters for them. If the ones you choose aren't really who matters to them, or if you really have no way to contact the ones who do matter, you are selling them short on an important part of their weekend. And if you

don't really know them, you may not be familiar with the connection they have with their home church. And after all, that's what Emmaus is all about - building leadership in the local church. Is this person even a church member? And if you don't happen to live where the person you want to sponsor lives, how will you handle getting that person to their follow up? These are important items for you as a sponsor to do well for your Pilgrim. And these are just a few. So regardless of how excited you may be, consider first how able you are.
