

- 1. Strengthen the local church.
- 2. Grow leadership in the local church.
- 3. Strengthen individual spirituality.
- 4. Develop a closer relationship with Jesus.
- 5. Teach us to work together.6. Teach us how to love
- others.
- 7. Teach us how to serve

others

WHAT EMMAUS IS NOT

- 1. Trying to outdo someone else.
- 2. Bringing attention to an individual.
- 3. Keeping up with the Jones (one-upping).
- 4. Going against Emmaus guidelines.
- 5. Being materialistic.

These are good reminders of the purpose of Emmaus when considering a person to sponsor. While it may be a result at times, the purpose is never to 'fix' a person. It is to enhance their service within their local church.

PRAYER

As new people are being named to our Cluster Board, and to the Alabama Community Board, it is so important to keep these people in your prayers. We are all familiar with the prayer that covers every aspect of the Walks. And we all know the value of that prayer. And as we all know, too, times are very different than they were, say, a year ago, or even five years ago.
