#### **RG CORNER**

Does your group use the Group Reunion cards - or the item sometimes referred to in the past as the service sheet? This has the order of the reunion on it and begins with the Prayer to the Holy Spirit. There is a review of each one's prayer, study and action. Then each is to share their closest to Christ moment during the previous week. There is then the Call to Discipleship followed by a discussion of being or not being a disciple and plans to grow in this area. Prayers follow this. Does your group follow this pattern?







#### **SPONSORSHIP 101**

The Alabama Community has Standing Rules that may not always get distributed to all members. So sometimes it's good to share them. Rule #20 states: 'A Conference Room member shall not sponsor a pilgrim, nor have a family member who is a pilgrim on that Walk. Other team members are strongly discouraged from sponsoring a pilgrim on a Walk that he or she is working.' Let's unpack this rule to see all that it says. First, Conference Room team members are working closely with the Pilgrims, and it may be difficult to give them their space. Others may sponsor a Pilgrim you know well, but it

helps everyone for you not to be that involved. How can you see to the family left at home if you are at Camp? Of course you could have a spouse who is not working see to it, but that is missing the point. The rule also says that as a Conference Room team member, you may not have a family member who is a Pilgrim on the same Walk, regardless of who sponsors them. The issue here is to give the Pilgrims the privacy and space to have Christ re-presented to them without the sense that someone who is close to them is measuring their reaction. It's a gift of agape.

# **MEETING LOCATIONS NOTE**The Cluster Board is working to

make meeting locations more like they were before the pandemic. It is usual for folks to attend nearer home, so having a location in Florence again would naturally help our members in Lauderdale County. This is a process at this time and not a set schedule.
