- 3. SHOP AT **THE BERKELEY FARMERS' MARKET:** THIS OUTDOOR MARKET IS HELD EVERY SATURDAY AND TUESDAY IN DOWNTOWN BERKELEY, OFFERING FRESH PRODUCE, FLOWERS, AND ARTISANAL GOODS. IT'S A GREAT PLACE TO TRY LOCAL CUISINE AND MINGLE WITH LOCALS.
- 4. CHECK OUT THE BERKELEY REPERTORY THEATRE: THIS TONY AWARD-WINNING THEATER OFFERS A VARIETY OF PLAYS AND MUSICALS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR, FEATURING BOTH ESTABLISHED AND EMERGING PLAYWRIGHTS.
- 5. VISIT THE BERKELEY PUBLIC LIBRARY: THIS MODERNIST BUILDING OFFERS FREE ACCESS TO BOOKS, MEDIA, AND OTHER RESOURCES, AND FEATURES BEAUTIFUL ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN.
