Notes about clock
-Upon initial inspection in customers home I found the clock was not working as it should. It did wind and tick but would stop after 10 minutes or so and mainspring would "bang" and spin out under more tension.
- There was no dial present and key was also missing.
- Main glass appeared in ok condition and no visible scratches.
- Upon opening the case, the hammer arm was twisted out of shape but did operate when clock went into warning.
- the chime was present .
- As the dial was missing i could have a closer look at the front of the movement which showed damage to ratchet wheels, several teeth bent over on the mainspring wheel, several screws crushed and incorrect wire holding a lot of parts in place.
- The damage through the movement is possibly caused from a broken outer hooking on the mainspring and or broken ratchet teeth so they will need repairing or replacing.
- I recommend a full service so we can fully inspect the movement and give an accurate cost of any extra repairs that may be needed to get the clock working as it was intended.
-The customer has agreed to a full service but also asked me to supply a new key and not to replace the dial but to polish certain parts of the front of the movement purely for asthetics.
