

2025 Rural Ghana Missions – Year In Review

Giving Thanks to God for a Year of Ministry and Impact

(Psalm 107:1) As we reflect on 2025, we do so first with hearts full of gratitude to **God**, whose grace and provision made every achievement possible. Through your prayers, generosity, and partnership, Rural Ghana Missions (RGM) witnessed lives touched physically, spiritually, and eternally.

Community Health Screening and Evangelism Campaign

2025 marked the **maiden edition** of our Community Health Screening and Evangelism Campaign in rural Ghana. Over a two-week period, more than **1,200 individuals**, including 300 schoolchildren, received health screenings. Even more importantly, **41 precious souls were baptized into Christ**, publicly declaring their faith and new life in Him. We praise God for the opportunity to meet physical needs while boldly proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Provision of Bibles for Newly Baptized



To encourage spiritual growth and discipleship, RGM purchased and distributed **41 Bibles** in both English and local languages to all newly baptized believers. Your support ensured that these new Christians now have access to God's Word as they grow in faith and obedience.

Church Support at Gomoa Nkoranzah

Through your generosity, **plastic chairs and wooden benches** were purchased for the Gomoa Nkoranzah Church. Children who once stood during class now have proper seating, creating a more welcoming and nurturing environment for learning God's Word.

During follow-up efforts after our mission trip, **eight additional baptisms** were recorded in this community—an encouragement that the Gospel continues to bear fruit.



Economic Empowerment for Women



RGM provided **start-up funds to four women** to help them begin small businesses and support their families. These initiatives not only promote dignity and self-sufficiency but also open doors for ongoing Gospel witness within their households and communities.

Medical Assistance



In addition to health screenings, funds were provided for **medical treatment** for individuals identified as needing urgent care. Your gifts brought tangible relief and demonstrated Christ's compassion in action.

Support for Rural Preachers



Understanding that the harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few, RGM supported **six rural preachers** and hired **one additional preacher** to strengthen follow-up and outreach efforts in the Gomoa Nkoranzah area. These faithful servants continue to shepherd, teach, and evangelize in challenging conditions.

Collection and Boxing of Donations

By God's provision and your generosity, **35 boxes of clothing and school supplies** were collected, boxed, and prepared for shipment to Ghana. These items will bless families and children in need. We continue to prayerfully seek donations for **medications and additional health screening supplies** for our upcoming outreach in May 2026.



Reconstruction of Zuarungu Church Building



RGM launched a fundraising campaign to help roof the **Zuarungu Church of Christ** building. This former charismatic church, now a Church of Christ congregation, currently worships under a makeshift overhang due to the absence of a roof. The church requires approximately **42 packs of roofing sheets at \$100 per pack**.
