- Interview and hire MSW and MH interns
- Conduct staff training & development as required.
- Conduct performance appraisals.
- Coordinate & oversee the admissions process in accordance with all relevant intake criteria.
- Submit monthly internal RYC reports.
- Monitor program for continued Improvement.
- Participate in all meetings, as assigned.
- Provide direct service to clients on an as-needed/required basis.
- Provide individual and group supervision of all program and support staff
- Facilitate weekly team meetings and case conferences.
- Facilitate Monthly Youth Council Meetings

- Supervise MSW students, as assigned.
- Conduct Professional Development on mission driven related topics including Mental Health and Social Emotional Learning.
- Provide Crisis Intervention Incident Reporting
- Other duties as assigned.
