The purpose of the Hualalai 'Ohana Foundation Honor Roll Award is to recognize the outstanding students of the Hualalai 'Ohana. Employees may be full-time, part-time, or casual, but must have passed their 90-day probation period in order to be eligible for the Honor Roll Award, and the student must be:

- **the employee's child, legal stepchild or legally adopted child.**
- **have completed the 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade of a;**
- **Hawaii private, public, or charter school (home-schooling is not eligible); and**
- **meet a final minimum GPA of 3.0 or B + for 2020-2021 school year.**

The Hualalai 'Ohana Foundation Board of Directors has established the Honor Roll Award amounts as:

- **\$150.00 for students in 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> grades and.**
- **\$250.00 for students in 9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grades**

To apply, please submit your child's report card along with the attached Enrollment Form by **Friday, June 25, 2021**. If your child's school is not publishing grades for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter, please submit your child's 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter report card instead.
