

About The Award

This program is designed to provide flexible support in the form of learning subscription programs. Choose a subscription program that works best for your family in the form of child literacy subscriptions for books (Dolly Parton Imagination Library) or travel subscription boxes (Little Passports). The following programs are supported by the Foundation at no cost to you:

Dolly Parton Imagination Library (keiki ages 0-4 years): Hualālai 'Ohana Foundation is an affiliate partner of The Dolly Parton's Imagination Library. The Imagination Library mails high-quality, age-appropriate books to registered children. These books are personalized with each child's name and mailed directly to their home to create a gifting experience that makes books exciting and encourages families to spend time enjoying books together.

Little Passports (keiki ages 5-12 years): Oh, the places you'll go! Little Passports is an award-winning travel subscription box mailed to your child each month. Each package is designed to spark your child's curiosity about the world so your keiki will know the true meaning of wanderlust at an early age. Inspire children to learn about the world around them, one monthly package at a time. This program is age-specific and developed by educators to encourage interest in geography, science, world discoveries and a life-long love of learning. 100% fun, kid-tested for maximum fun.

Eligibility Guidelines

1. Must be a Hualālai Community Employee*. Hualālai Community Employee* includes Hualālai Investors LLC, Four Seasons Hualālai, and Hualālai Resort contractor employees.

- Hualālai Resort contractor employees must provide (2) two employment references with their application.

2. The Hualālai Community employee must be employed with the resort for at least 90 days (must have passed probation) at the time of application.

3. The Hualālai Community employee must work a minimum average of 20 hours a week or more.

Eligible Recipients

1. Hualālai Community Employee's children ages 0-12 years of age are eligible. Employees who are legal guardians of children they are applying for must provide documentation of legal guardianship.

Application Requirements

1. Submit an online application on 'Ohana Online.
2. Choose either the Dolly Parton Imagination Library program or the Little Passports supported learning subscription programs and the Hualālai 'Ohana Foundation will register your keiki automatically once your application is reviewed and approved.

Award Procedure

1. The Hualālai 'Ohana Foundation will register your keiki automatically once your application is reviewed and approved.
2. If the employee ends employment within the Hualālai Community, HOF will immediately cancel your subscription plan.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. *Can I choose more than one subscription program for my child?*
 - a. No, you may only choose one (1) subscription program per application. However, you can apply when your application expires.
2. *Do I need to reapply every year?*
 - a. For Dolly Parton Imagination Library (0-age 4) NO you do not need to reapply, you will continue to receive books each month until your child ages out at the age of 5, if you continue to meet the employment requirements. Employment verifications will be made.
 - b. For Little Passports (5 years to 12 years), YES you must reapply every year when your subscription ends to be considered for a new subscription.
3. *Can I apply for multiple children?*
 - a. Yes, you can apply for each eligible child (age 0-12). Each child can receive their own subscription.
4. *What happens to my subscription if I leave my job at Hualālai?*
 - a. If you end employment within the Hualālai Community, the Foundation will immediately cancel your subscription plan.
